


FRONT A-ARM GUARDS YAMAHA GRIZZLY 700 (2014+)



PREPARATION

- Using a jack under center of front end, lift until the front wheels leave the ground.
- Remove the wheels.
- Remove both factory A-arm guards.
- As shown below, stick the rubber strip on the new PERFEX A-arm guards.
- Install the rubber clamps on the suspension arms (see image below).



INSTALLATION

- Install the guards to the suspension arms, using the factory mounting points (where the factory guards were connected). Use M6 hex bolts and 3/16" spacers to secure the guards to the arms.
 NOTE: Put the spacers between the guards and the arms.
- Secure the inside portion of the guards using the provided steel brackets.
 NOTE: Use the bigger brackets for the front with M6 hex bolts.
 NOTE 2: Use the smaller brackets on the back with M6 carriage bolts and M6 lock nuts.
- 3. Fix the bottom of the guards to the rubber clamps using M6 carriage bolts and M6 lock nuts.
- 4. Tight all the hardware once the guards are correctly installed.
- 5. Put the wheels back on the ATV. Torque all lugs to factory specification. NOTE: Check that the a-arm guards will clear the others components of the ATV. Re-adjust the guards if it's necessary.





PREPARATION

- Using a jack under center of rear end, lift until the rear wheels leave the ground.
- Remove the wheels.
- Remove both factory A-arm guards.
- As shown below, stick the rubber strip on the new PERFEX A-arm guards.
- Install the rubber clamps on the suspension arms (see image below).



INSTALLATION

- 6. Install the guards to the suspension arms, using the factory mounting points (where the factory guards were connected on the back). Use M6 hex bolts to secure the guards to the arms.
- 7. Fix the front of the guards to the rubber clamps using M6x25mm carriage bolts and M6 lock nuts.
- 8. Secure the guards to the arms using the remaining M6x50mm carriage bolts and M6 lock nuts.
- 9. Tight all the hardware once the guards are correctly installed.
- 10. Put the wheels back on the ATV. Torque all lugs to factory specification. NOTE: Check that the a-arm guards will clear the others components of the ATV. Re-adjust the guards if it's necessary.
