



## **PREPARATION**

- Using a jack under center of front end, lift until the front wheels leave the ground.
- Remove the wheels.
- Remove the factory plastic A-arm guards.
- Using the image below as a guide, insert and pinch the rubber clamps on the a-arm, on each side.
- Stick the rubber strips on the a-arm guards. See image below.



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## **INSTALLATION**


1. Install the guards to the suspension arms. Use the M6x20mm hex flange bolts, M6 washer and M6 lock nuts to secure the guards to the arms.

**NOTE:** Put the washers with the lock nuts, over the mounting points on the A-arms.



- 2. Secure the bottom of the guards to the rubber clamps. Use the M6x20mm carriage bolts and M6 lock nuts.
- 3. Tight all the hardware appropriately once the guards are correctly installed.
- 4. Put the wheels back on the ATV. Torque all lugs to factory specification.

**NOTE:** Check that the a-arm guards will clear the others components of the ATV. Re-adjust the guards if it's necessary.



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

## **PREPARATION**

- Using a jack under center of rear end, lift until the rear wheels leave the ground.
- Remove the wheels.
- Remove both factory plastic A-arm guards.

## **INSTALLATION**

5. Install the clamps (14) to the suspension arms. Use the M10 bolts (2x) and M10 lock nut (1x). See image below. **NOTE:** The bolt on the right side will be bolted into the brake caliper.






6. Install the clamps (13) to the suspension arms. Use the M6x25mm bolts (2x) with M6 lock nuts (2x). See image below. **NOTE:** Tight both brackets. Re-adjust later if necessary.





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7. Install the clamps (12) to the new aluminum A-arm guards. Use the M6x16mm bolts (4x) with M6 cup washers (4x) and M6 lock nuts (4x). Refer to the image below. Do NOT tight now.



- 8. Install the new guards to the suspension arms. Use the M6x20mm carriage bolts (4x) with M6 lock nuts (4x) to secure the bottom of the guards to the clamps (14).
- 9. Secure the guards to the clamps (13) using the remaining M6x20mm bolts (2x), M6 cup washers (2x) and M6 lock nuts (2x).
- 10. Tight all the hardware once the guards are correctly installed & adjusted.
  - Use a 10mm wrench and socket for the M6 hardware.
  - Use a 17mm wrench and socket for the M10 hardware.

**NOTE:** Start to tight hardware that are bolted to the clamps (13) and (14).

11. Put the wheels back on the ATV. Torque all lugs to factory specification.

NOTE: Check that the a-arm guards will clear the others components of the ATV. Re-adjust the guards if it's necessary.



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
