ALL recycling materials must be UNBAGGED, empty, have lids off, and single-material.

GLASS:

yes • jars
• bottles } all colors

no • drinkware
• mirrors/windows
• home décor

PLASTIC:

yes • bottles
• jars
• jugs
• tubs } all numbers
(1-7)

no • tubes*
◦ e.g. toothpaste
• shopping bags & film
plastics*
◦ e.g. bubble wrap
• chip bags*
• clamshells (berries etc)
• styrofoam* & packing
peanuts
• six-pack beverage rings*
• lids, pumps, sprayers, etc*
• to-go cups, straws, & lids*

ALWAYS NO:

textiles, wood, to-go food containers of all kinds, paint cans, ceramics, batteries, rubber, toys, electronics, things that tangle (cords, cables, rope, hoses, chains, etc.), medical waste, hazardous substances, furniture

METAL:

yes • food & drink cans
• jar lids
◦ separated from jars
◦ larger than 2" diam.
• aerosol cans
◦ must be EMPTY

no • aluminum foil
◦ of any collected size
• metal tubes*
◦ e.g. skincare, tomato
paste, etc
• accessories
• razors* & sharps

PAPER:

yes • all cartons
• un-coated cardboard of all
kinds
◦ flattened
◦ tape removed
• paper

wet is
okay!

no • any paper contaminated with
oils or food*
• receipts
• shredded paper
• napkins, tissues, paper towels*
- clean or used
• remove plastic windows from
boxes & envelopes
