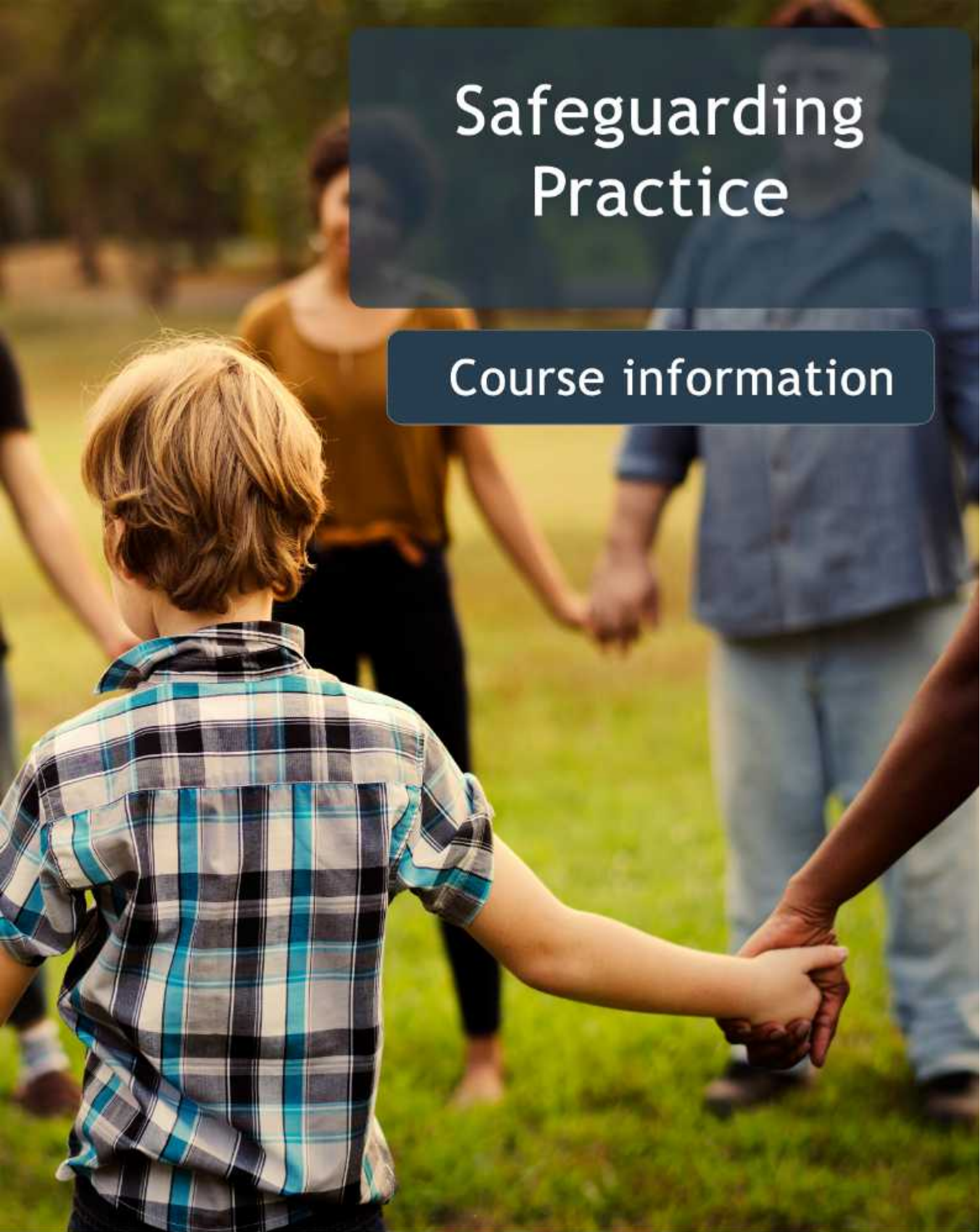

Overview

Safeguarding is a serious responsibility, make sure you are informed! This package covers safeguarding children and adults, plus the responsibility of writing a policy and leading on safeguarding issues as the designated person.

The courses contained in this bundle are:

Safeguarding Adults (Level 2) - Understand the different forms of abuse, signs and symptoms, susceptibility to abuse, the legislative framework, responding professionally to a disclosure, reporting incidents and concerns and more.

Safeguarding Children (Level 2) - Overview of legislation, signs and symptoms or abuse, behaviour indicators, family circumstances and risks, responding to a disclosure, reporting abuse, maintaining confidential records, GDPR, information sharing and more.

Safeguarding Designated Lead Person - Legislation, role of a designated person, reporting requirements and processes, the role of external agencies, position of trust, safeguarding boards and more.

Safeguarding Policies and Procedures - Duty of care, confidentiality and information sharing, protecting and supporting staff, links to other policies, links to external agencies, key elements of a robust policy.
