Overview

Ladder accidents are extremely common even though they are preventable. Employers often require staff members to use ladders, but employees may not know how to use ladders safely.

The course explores how employers and employees can reduce and control the risks associated with using ladders and will increase skills and knowledge of the different types of ladders (including step ladders) and how to use them safely.

This course is for employers and employees who would benefit from up-to-date knowledge and skills around ladder safety.

This course contains the following modules:

Module 1 - An introduction to ladder safety - In this module you will explore hazards at work, statistics, common injuries, consequences of fall accidents and use of ladder policy.

Module 2 - Legislation and responsibilities - In this module you will look at all legislation relevant to ladder safety and how to ensure that you are compliant.

Module 3 - Types of ladders, classifications, and use - In this module you will explore different types of ladders, ladder stabilising devices, ladder classification and how to choose the right ladder.

Module 4 - Safe use of ladders and usage - In this module you will look at pre-use checklists, planning, carrying and securing a ladder, setting up a ladder and safe ascending and descending.

Module 5 - How to undertake a risk assessment - In this module you will look at managing risk, risk assessment, hazards and risks, likelihood and severity of risk, risk control hierarchy and barriers.
