*4 yards backing of choice *70" x 78" quilt batting


1 yd. FABRIC A: PATT\#10524 - Farmall Patriotic panel
Cut scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ past outside edges of panel, approx. 36-1/2" x 44-1/2"
3/4 yd. FABRIC B: PATT\#10525 - Farmall Patriotic Barns
Fussy cut (8) 6-3/4" squares with barns centered
1/3 yd. FABRIC C: PATT\#10526 - Farm Signs
Cut (1) 6-3/4"x WOF, subcut (6) 6-3/4" squares
1/2 yd. FABRIC D: PATT\#10527-Tractors on plaid
Cut (1) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, subcut (2) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
1/2 yd. FABRIC E: PATT\#10528 - Tossed Logos - Natural
Cut (1) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, subcut (2) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
5/8 yd. FABRIC F: PATT\#10528 - Tossed Logos - Red
Cut (1) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, subcut (4) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut (2) $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut (16) $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
1/2 yd. FABRIC G: PATT\#10529 - Farmall Sunflowers
Cut (2) $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut (16) $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
1 yd. FABRIC H: PATT\#5174 - Chocolate Batik
Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips (binding)
Cut (7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips
1 yd. FABRIC I: PATT\#5174 - Navy Batik
Cut (1) 6-1/4" $x$ WOF, subcut (4) 6-1/4" squares and
(2) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares

Cut (6) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, subcut (14) 3 " squares (from 1 strip)
Cut (2) 2-7/8"x WOF, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares
5/8 yd. FABRIC J: PATT\#5174 - Olive Batik
Cut (3) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, subcut (16) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares


7/8 yd. FABRIC K: PATT\#5174 - Red Batik
Cut (3) 3-7/8" x WOF; subcut (28) 3-7/8" squares
Cut (6) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders, (2) 2-1/2" x $48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders, and (4) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces

5/8 yd. FABRIC L: PATT\#5174 - Turquoise Batik Cut (3) 5-1/2" x WOF, subcut (16) 5-1/2" squares

## Piecing the Blocks:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the Fabric I 2-7/8" squares, Fabric J 5-1/2" squares, and Fabric L $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Arrange a marked Fabric I 2-7/8" square right sides together on corner of a Fabric K 3-7/8" square as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press corner out. Make a total of 24. Cut each in half perpendicular to the seam allowance to create 24 each Units 1 a and 1 b ( $3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished).


## 3. Cut 4 Fabric $\mathbf{K} 3-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares in half diagonally.

4. Mark the $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ center point on all sides of a Fabric B 6-3/4" square as shown. Draw diagonal
 lines from mark to mark. Trim corners from square. Repeat for a total of 8 trimmed $\mathbf{B}$ squares and 6 trimmed $\mathbf{C}$ squares (4-3/4" square unfinished).
5. Stitch 2 Fabric K 3-7/8" triangles, 1 Unit 1a, and 1 Unit 1b to edges of a Fabric B 4-3/4" square as shown. Add a Fabric K 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece to top. Make a total of 2 Block 1 ( $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 Block 2 noting orientation of the pieces and units.

6. Stitch 2 each Units 1a and 1 b to edges of a Fabric B 4-3/4" square as shown. Make a total of 4 Block 3 ( $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished). In the same manner, make 6 Block 4 with a Fabric C $4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square.

7. Arrange 2 marked Fabric L 5-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a Fabric F 10-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press corners out. Repeat on remaining corners. Make a total of 4 Block 5 (10-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 each Blocks 6 and 7 with fabrics indicated.


Block 5-Make 4 Block 6-Make 2 Block 7 - Make 2
8. Cut all Fabrics $\mathbf{F}$ and $\mathbf{G} 3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares in half diagonally.
 9. Cut all Fabric 16-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice.
10. Sew 1 each Fabrics $\mathbf{F}$ and G 3-3/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 16 Unit 2

Unit 2 ( $3^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished).
11. Arrange 4 Unit 2 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 ( $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished).

12. Stitch 1 each Fabrics F and G 3-3/8" triangles to short edges of a Fabric I 6-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 4 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished).


Unit 4 - Make 16
13. Arrange 4 Fabric I 3" squares, 1 Unit 3, and 4 Unit 4 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 8 (10-1/2" square unfinished).

## Assembling the Quilt Top:

14. Refer to Quilt Layout on Page 4 for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.


Block 8 - Make 4
15. Stitch Fabric I 3" strips to right and left sides of Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Sew 3 Fabric 1 3" strips together end to end. Cut into 2 equal lengths and stitch to top and bottom of panel. Trim an even amount from Fabric I strips so bordered panel is $40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (unfinished).
16. Sew Fabric K 2-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2$ borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.
17. Arrange 1 Block 1, 1 Block 2, 2 Block 3, and 3 Block 4 in vertical rows on right and left sides of the bordered panel. Stitch blocks into side borders ( $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished). Sew side borders to sides of bordered panel.
18. Arrange 2 Block 5, 1 Block 6, 1 Block 7, and 2 Block 8 in horizontal rows above and below quilt. Stitch into top/bottom borders (10-1/2" $x$ 60-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
19. Sew Fabric K 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
20. Sew 7 Fabric H 1-1/2" xWOF strips together end to end and cut into (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 68-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add 62-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

## Applique:

21. Trace (6) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares on paper side of a light fusible web leaving about $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ between squares. Cut out each square with about $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ extra around each square.
22. Arrange the squares web side down on the wrong side of Fabric G. Lightly press to fabrics according to web manufacturer's directions.
23. Referring to quilt image, arrange squares on quilt top centered between Blocks 5, 6 , and 7 . When in place, press squares according to web manufacturer's directions.
24. Using a satin, or decorative stitch, hand or machine stitch around each square.

## Finishing:

25. Cut backing into 2 equal lengths. Sew backing pieces together along their selvage edges.
26. Layer backing, right side down, batting, then quilt top, right side up. Baste layers together. Quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with quilt top.
27. Stitch Fabric H binding strips together with diagonal seams. Press binding strip in half lengthwise and apply to quilt.
