# **RealTree Plank Quilt**



Quilt size: Approx. 60" x 76" A free project using Realtree Plank fabrics from Sykel Enterprises www.sykelenterprises.com

#### Supplies Needed: \*Yardage listed for each print \*4 yards backing of choice \*68" x 84" quilt batting

**1 yd. FABRIC A**: PATT#10517 - Realtree Plank panel Trim to 33-1/2" x 41" with motif centered



**1/4 yd. FABRIC B**: PATT#10518 - Realtree Plank boxes Cut (1) 5" x WOF (width of fabric), subcut (2) 5" squares



**3/8 yd. FABRIC C**: PATT#10519 - Realtree Plank patch Cut (2) 4-1/8" x WOF, subcut (18) 4-1/8" squares



**3/4 yd. FABRIC D**: PATT#10520 - Realtree Plank deer Cut (1) 13-3/4" x WOF, subcut (2) 7" x 13-3/4" tall pieces and (2) 7" tall x 12-3/4" pieces Cut (2) 4-1/8" x WOF, subcut (18) 4-1/8" squares



**1 yd. FABRIC E**: PATT#10521 - Realtree branches Cut (1) 15" x WOF, subcut (8) 4-1/4" x 15" tall strips

**1-2/3 yds. FABRIC F**: PATT#10522 - Realtree stripe Fussy cut (3) 5" x WOF deer stripe Fussy cut (3) 4-1/4" x WOF gray silhouette stripe

**3/8 yd. FABRIC G**: PATT#5174 - Asphalt Batik Cut (6) 1-1/2" x WOF, from 2 strips cut (4) 1-1/2" x 7" and (4) 1-1/2" x 5" pieces

**1-1/4 yds. FABRIC H**: PATT#5174 - Chocolate Batik Cut (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips

**1-5/8 yds. FABRIC I**: PATT#5174 - Navy Batik Cut (2) 7-3/4" x WOF, subcut (9) 7-3/4" squares Cut (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips (binding) Cut (4) 1-3/4" x WOF strips Cut (3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips





### **Piecing the Blocks:**

1. Cut each Fabric I 7-3/4" squares in half diagonally twice for a total of 36 QSTs (Quarter Square Triangles).



2. Cut the 18 Fabric C 4-1/8" squares in half diagonally only as shown. Cut the 18 Fabric D 4-1/8" squares in half diagonally only as shown.

3. Sew 1 each Fabrics C and D 4-1/8" triangles to short edges of each Fabric I 7-3/4" OST to create 9 each Blocks 1a-1d (3-3/4" x 7" unfinished), noting orientation of the **C** and **D** prints.

4. Stitch 2 Fabric G 1-1/2" x 5" pieces to right and left sides of a Fabric B 5" square. Add 2 Fabric G 1-1/2" x 7" pieces to top and bottom. Make a total of 2 Block 2

(7" square unfinished).

## Assembling the Quilt Top:

5. Refer to Quilt Layout on Page 4 for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

6. Stitch Fabric G 1-1/2" x WOF strips to right and left sides of Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x WOF strips to top and bottom of panel and trim strip ends even.

7. Arrange the 9 Block 1c and 1 Fabric D 7" x 13-3/4" tall piece in a vertical row on left side of bordered panel. Stitch into border (7" x 43" unfinished). Sew border to left side of bordered panel.

8. Arrange the 9 Block 1d and 1 Fabric D 7" x 13-3/4" tall piece in a vertical row on right side of bordered panel. Stitch into border (7" x 43" unfinished). Sew border to right side of bordered panel.

9. Arrange the 9 Block 1a, 1 Block 2, and a Fabric D 7" tall x 12-3/4" piece in a row above quilt. Stitch into border (7" x 48-1/2" unfinished). Sew border to top of quilt.

10. Arrange the 9 Block 1b, 1 Block 2, and a Fabric D 7" tall x 12-3/4" piece in a row below quilt. Stitch into border (7" x 48-1/2" unfinished). Sew border to bottom of quilt.

11. Sew 6 Fabric H 1-1/2" strips together end to end. From this, cut (2) 1-1/2" x 56" and (2) 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders. Stitch 56" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Sew 50-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Trace the Triangle Template 204 times and 4 each Half-Triangle A and B Template on paper side of light weight fusible web. Leave about 1/8" between tracings. Press remaining Fabric H. Place fusible web down on wrong side of Fabric H. Press webbing to fabric according to web manufacturer's instructions. Cut out each triangle and half-triangle along the marked lines.

13. Sew the 3 Fabric F 5" x WOF strips together end to end. From this, cut (2) 5" x 58" (unfinished) borders.

14. Sew the 3 Fabric F 4-1/4" x WOF strips together end to end. From this, cut (2) 4-1/4" x 58" (unfinished) borders.

15. Sew 4 Fabric E 4-1/4" x 15" strips together end to end. From this, cut (1) 4-1/4" x 58" (unfinished) border. Repeat to create a second border.

16. Arrange 25 Fabric H triangles and 1 each Fabric H A and B half-triangles web side down on **both long edges of each Fabric E** 4-1/4" x 58". Space the triangles evenly along each side of borders, remembering that 1/4'' on ends and long edges will be sewn into seams. Press triangles in place according to web manufacturer's instructions.

Side Sawtooth Borders - Make 2

17. Arrange 26 Fabric H triangles web side down on both long edges of each Fabric F 4-1/4" x 58". Space the triangles evenly along each side of borders, remembering that 1/4" on ends and long edges will be sewn into seams. Press triangles in place according to web manufacturer's instructions.

Top/Bottom Sawtooth Borders - Make 2

18. Using a satin, or decorative stitch, hand or machine stitch around each triangle. Lining the border with a tear-away stabilizer will help keep the border flat as you work. Triangles do not need to be appliqued on edges of border that will be stitched into seams.

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19. Sew Side Sawtooth borders to right and left sides of quilt.

20. Stitch **Fabric F** 5" x 58" borders (Step 13) to top and bottom of quilt. Add Top/Bottom Sawtooth borders to top and bottom of quilt.

21. Sew 4 **Fabric I** 1-3/4" strips together end to end. From this, cut (2) 1-3/4" x 74-1/2" borders. Stitch borders to right and left sides of quilt.

22. Sew 3 **Fabric I** 1-1/2" strips together end to end. From this, cut (2) 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders. Stitch borders to top and bottom of quilt.

#### **Finishing:**

23. Cut backing into 2 equal lengths. Sew backing pieces together along their selvage edges.

24. Layer backing, right side down, batting, then quilt top, right side up. Baste layers together. Quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with quilt top.

25. Stitch **Fabric I** binding strips together with diagonal seams. Press binding strip in half lengthwise and apply to quilt.







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
