Suggestions

- Take the Wheelie Painters out and trundle them through puddles. See the
- patterns they make on the dry parts of the playground.
- Put long rolls of paper on the floor (old wall paper can be used). Dip the painter in
- the paint and then make a pattern twisting and turning as you go (you may need
- to tape some paper down to avoid slipping accidents.
- Create a large, enclosed canvas. Cover an area with paper, the surround it with
- bricks, blocks etc. The blocks will enclose the area. (Children will need to wear
- wellingtons for this). Dip the Wheelie Painter in different coloured paints and then
- create your own piece of modern art.
- Try using the Wheelie Painters in different textures to see if a pattern can be
- made. Long trays are useful for containing the materials, such as sand, magic
- snow etc. (Some materials may get stuck in the tyre treads)

Care Instructions

When the art work is completed wash the Wheelie Painters with a warm, soapy solution and leave to dry.
