

Mark Making Sequin Stripe Board

This multi-coloured sequin board has different bands for children to discover and reveal what is hidden beneath. This supports children's fine motor development as well as being an engaging and absorbing activity.

- Children will need to think about which way they can stroke and manipulate the sequins for them to reveal the hidden colour beneath. This develops children's fine motor skills as they isolate individual digits. Perhaps you could extend by providing children with tools to mark making such as paintbrushes and sticks.
- Perhaps you could create little arrows from card or paper to attach to the board. Encourage the children to mark make in a particular route. Or you could create cards with the colours of each stripe. It might start on red, second yellow, third green and fourth blue.
- This sparkly board is a wonderful resource to encourage children to think about colours.
 Perhaps you could place in a bag the four colour cards of yellow, blue, red and green.
 Encourage the children to take out one card. Once they have selected their card they could try and find items around the setting that matches with the colour. Take this opportunity to discuss the different tones and shades. Red is not always red, it is crimson, ruby, scarlet etc.
- Why not place this glittery board in a sensory environment. Children can interact with the sequins in a calm and soothing environment that encourages their sensory exploration.
