



YOU PROBABLY HAVE ONE ON EVERY DOORWAY IN YOUR HOME AND SCHOOL. YOU CAN FIND IT AT THE ENTRANCE TO EVERY KOSHER RESTAURANT, SO MANY STORES, YOUR FRIEND'S HOUSES...
I'M SURE YOU KNOW WHAT I'M TALKING ABOUT... A MEZUZAH.

Have you stopped to think about the mezuzah anytime recently? It's easy to forget it's there!

- You might know that a Mezuzah is protection for a home. You may kiss it every time you go in and out. Maybe you know what's inside the case.
 - But, did you know hanging a mezuzah is one of the 613 mitzvos?
- And, do you know what it says inside? And why we kiss it?
- Inside the mezuzah is a parchment with 2 parts of Shema written on it. These paragraphs remind us to love Hashem & to keep the mitzvos. We put a mezuzah on every doorway to a room in our homes (except the bathroom). And, it has become our custom to "kiss the mezuzah".
- What we actually do is- touch the mezuzah as we enter the room & then kiss the fingertips that touched the mezuzah. Doing this reminds us of Hashem and reminds us to do mitzvos.
- So, this week let's become mezuzah masters, remembering that every time you enter or leave a room, you should kiss the mezuzah & remind yourself to love Hashem & do mitzvos.
- YOU PROBABLY WALK IN & OUT OF ROOMS TONS OF TIMES EVERY DAY, SO LET'S TRACK 5
 TIMES A DAY THIS WEEK. REMEMBER TO COUNT THOSE 5 TIMES THAT YOU KISS THE MEZUZAH
 & REMIND YOURSELF THAT YOU ARE A SHLIACH, DOING MITZVOS & LOVING HASHEM.
- Don't forget to jot the 5 times down on the chart below & add them to the mitzvah counter.

 And of course, invite your friends along on the mission & share the mezuzah reminder card with them.
