



Adventure in Color Quilt

General Instructions

Read through all the instructions for each block before beginning. Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam unless otherwise specified. Seam allowances are built into the cutting directions. All pieces are sewn with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise specified.

Cutting directions for fabrics is based on fabric 40" wide- adjust the quantity as needed to fit your fabrics. WOF means width of fabric; WOF for all the fabrics is assumed to be 40". Fabric requirements for the borders allow enough for diagonal piecing.

The quilt was made in 2 colorways- the **Dawn** colorway has a light background and the **Dusk** colorway has a dark background. In each block pattern, the diagrams reflect the light background quilt. If you are making the quilt using the dark background, follow the instructions using the fabric letters as a guide and refer to the block image.

A Color chart is included- it is a great way to keep track of the fabrics that you choose for your quilt!

For many of the blocks, we have listed the exact size needed to make the Half Square Triangle (HST) units and the Flying Geese (FG) units. **BUT**, if like us, you want a little wiggle room and are willing to trim your units to size, we suggest cutting them a little oversize. We have listed a size if you want to cut oversized in each block's pattern.

If you are a fan of the Tucker line of tools- the Tucker Trimmer and the Wing Clipper for example, we have a handout on how to "Tuckerize" the cutting as well!

There are 6 different blocks in the quilt. Month 7 is the setting. We list both the finished size of the block (the size once it is sewn into the quilt) and the unfinished size. Be sure to trim the block to the **unfinished** size- NOT the finished size!

Tools and Supplies

The only supplies you need to make this quilt are your basic quilting supplies such as a rotary cutter, mat, ruler, seam ripper, thread, sewing machine, etc....

Here is a list of tools we recommend to make the process easier!

- Sewing Guide
- Sewing Edge
- Best Press or Flatter
- Quilter's Magic Wand
- Sewline Fabric Pencil or the Clover Chaco Liner
- Sandpaper board
- Tucker Trimmer or your favorite Half Square Triangle ruler
- Wing Clipper or your favorite Flying Geese ruler
- 8 1/2" x 24 1/2" long ruler- really helpful for trimming the quilt center to size
