- that ALL mating components fit together.
- that there are no damaged components.
- that the system you have purchased is appropriate for your vehicle year, model and configuration.
- that the system will not interfere with any modifications previously installed or planned.
- that you have read and understand these instructions.

If you have any questions or are uncertain about any aspect of the installation of this system to your vehicle please contact your dealer before commencing installation.

## Removal of Stock System:

1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
2. Remove the bolts from the rear flange of the $y$-pipe. Do not discard the bolts as they will be reused for the installation.
3. Remove the hangers from the rubber isolators and remove the stock muffler and tail pipe. Retain the gasket from the $y$-pipe for reuse.

## Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:

1. Beginning with the Front Pipe, attach it to the $Y$-pipe using the bolts that were previously removed. Refer to Figure 1. The Front Pipe does not require cutting to fit $140.6^{\prime \prime}$ wheelbase trucks. For $127.4^{\prime \prime}$ wheelbase trucks, approximately $131 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ needs to be cut off from the end of the pipe without the flange.
Refer to the Cut Diagram.
(Installation tip: Temporarily hang the Muffler and the Front Pipe in place and measure to the $Y$-pipe to verify the length required).

2. Loosely place the 3" Hanger Clamp over the end of the Front Pipe and install the hanger into the factory rubber isolator.
3. Install the Muffler onto the front pipe, leaving the clamps loose. Refer to Figure 2. Place the 3" Clamp over the muffler outlet.
4. Place the Tail Pipe over the rear axle and install it by inserting the pipe into the Muffler, and the hangers into the factory isolators. Do not fully tighten the 3" Clamp yet. Refer to Figure 3.
5. Install and adjust the Exhaust Tip to suit. Tighten the lock bolt located on the Exhaust Tip. Refer to Figure 4.
6. Make sure that the exhaust is properly in place before tightening clamps. Start at the front of the exhaust system and begin tightening all connections.
