Skin Types & Conditions:

• Great for acneic, oily, and aging skin types. Also works well for hyperpigmentation and scarring.

Important Notes:

- Professional use only
- This treatment shouldn't be performed on any client:
 - Who suffers from any skin condition or serious medical condition, such as immune disease, cancer, diabetes, eczema, psoriasis, or herpes
 - Who are allergic to asprin
 - Who are pregnant or lactating
 - Who have an active facial rash, cold sores, or lesions
- A patch test is recommended 24-48 hours prior to this peel procedure
- Sun protection should be used after this service
- Accutane: 1 year off
- Retin-A: Discontinue for 7-10 days prior to treatment
- Permanent Cosmetics: Wait 7 days then cover with occlusive barrier
- Immediately Post Lift or Facial Surgery: Needs doctor approval
- Rosacea: Will need to be evaluated
- Facial Waxing: Requires a 72-hour waiting period

What to Do:

- 1. Cleanse and tone the skin thoroughly, removing all makeup and debris. Perform a double cleanse, if necessary, and degrease with an AHA Toner. We recommend Moor Spa Glycolic Toner.
- 2. Apply petroleum jelly to the area under the lash line, around the nostrils, the vermilion border of the lips, and the corners of the mouth.
- 3. Apply the Jessner Peel in 4-6 thin layers (depending on Fitzpatrick skin type), beginning at the forehead and working down to the jaw line in short, even strokes while avoiding the eyes, nose, and mouth. Allow the first layer to dry completely before applying more layers. "Frosting" will be visible and a fan is recommended for client comfort.
- 4. This peel is self-neutralizing when used alone. Once applied to the affected areas, it *cannot* be neutralized.
- 5. To cool the skin, rinse treated area with a gentle cream cleanser (we recommend Moor Spa Cleansing Milk). Gently massage any residual hot spots. Water alone may spike and trigger acids to further process.
- 6. Instruct client to protect skin from any and all sun exposure on their way home.

Aftercare:

- Recommend that clients not wash their face for 24 hours.
- Instruct the client to resume their normal regimen in the morning, especially sunscreen application.
- The peeling from the treatment can last up to 5-6 days.
- Schedule the client for 7 days after the peel for a gentle enzyme facial.
