

Rear Storage Pouch Installation Guide

Recommended tools:

Small Philips screwdriver Large Philips/flathead screwdriver

Step 1: Looking inside the rear luggage compartment, locate the two novelty plastic screws that are situated closest to the rear tailgate underneath both rear side windows. Using the small Philips screwdriver, remove these two screws from both sides of the car and set them aside.

Step 2: Screw two of the supplied threaded eyelets into the holes vacated by the screws on both sides of the car. Tighten the eyelets into position by hand, being careful not to over tighten them. **Please note:** if you have already installed the **Rear Luggage Area Cover**, you can use the existing eyelets that are fitted during the installation of this product.





Step 3: Locate the two large novelty plastic screws located at the back of the luggage area, low down within the tailgate area. Using a large Philips or flathead screwdriver, remove these two screws and set them to one side.

Step 4: Screw two of the supplied threaded eyelets into the holes vacated by these screws on both sides of the tailgate area. Tighten the eyelets into position by hand, being careful not to over tighten them.





Step 5: lay out the Rear Storage Pouch within your luggage area with the zip facing down and the edge with the velcro straps furthest away from you. Begin to thread the velcro straps through the lower two eyelets and loosely secure them.

Step 6: lift up the Rear Storage Pouch and clip the upper edge into place using the two uppermost eyelets. You can then adjust the lower velcro straps and upper straps accordingly to ensure that the Rear Storage Pouch is held securely in place. We recommend setting the straps slightly loose to ensure that the clips can be unclipped/clipped on again easily.
