

Water-Based Sealant

Bond It Bath & Kitchen is a high quality, flexible, water-based sealant that forms a watertight seal to most surfaces. It contains a powerful antifungal compound to prevent mold growth. Easy water clean-up. Low VOC content.

Product Use

For use as a grout repair and for sealing around all types of bathtubs, basins, sinks, toilets, countertops, and backsplash. Adheres to plastics, ceramics, glass, granite, marble, porcelain, vinyl, plaster, and wood. Not suitable for areas constantly submerged in water.


Application / Instructions

Surfaces must be clean, dry, and dust or grease-free. Remove all existing sealant. When sealing around bathtubs, fill the tub half full of water to position the bath at midpoint of any potential joint movement. Cut the tip of the cartridge without damaging the threaded area. Screw on nozzle and cut at an angle of 45° to an opening slightly larger than the gap to be sealed. Use foam backing rod to fill any deep gaps between the wall and bath to form a backing for sealant. Apply using a standard sealant gun and tool down within 10 minutes of application using the appropriate tool. Protect from water for at least 24 hours after sealing or until a tough skin has formed. Thorough ventilation will aid the curing process. Clean tools with soapy water after use. Regular cleaning of the sealed joint will prevent mold build-up.

Surface Preparation

For best results, surface should be clean, dry and structurally sound.

Limitations

This product is not a silicone sealant! Not suitable when:

- applied externally during rainy weather.
- applied at temperatures below 41°F (+5°C).
- used in joints constantly immersed in water.
- used in contact with bituminous products.
- used in areas of high abrasion, e.g. floor joints.
- for use with plastic baths use a sealant with greater flexibility

Storage & Shelf Life

Store in cool, dry conditions, protect from frost.

Product should be stored in the original, unopened container. Use within 24 months of date of manufacture.

Cleanup

Clean up excess wet caulk with a damp sponge before it cures. Excess dried caulk must cut or scraped off. Wash hands and tools with warm water and soap.

Disposal

Empty containers must be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations. Do not leave empty or partially used containers where residue could be harmful to children, animals, or the environment.
