Bond It Gutter & Roof Plus is a premium grade, neutral cure roofing silicone that is compatible with lead and most common building materials. Remains permanently flexible and is tough enough to stand up to the harshest of weather conditions

Product Use

For use on all types of roofing, roof vents, soffits, downspouts, siding, and gutters and as a lap jointing sealant. Good adhesion to acrylic, glass, GRP and polycarbonate glazing, aluminum, copper, lead, PVCu, steel, timber, industrial roofing panels, slate, and tiles. Also suitable for internal use for sub-roof ducting and for sealing roof lights, mechanical fasteners, and clogging, as well as HVAC and solar energy system installations.

Application / Instructions


Surfaces must be clean, dry and dust/grease free. When sealing deep joints, use foam backer rods to reduce wastage. Prime porous materials prior to use. Cut the tip of the cartridge without damaging the threaded area. Screw on the nozzle and cut at an angle of 45° to an opening slightly larger than the gap to be sealed. Apply using a standard sealant gun and tool down after 2-3 minutes using the appropriate tool. This silicone will stretch up to at least 25%. When using as an adhesive, ensure materials are bedded firmly into position. After use, clean tools with mineral spirits before product dries.

Surface Preparation

Ensure all surfaces are clean, dry and free from grease or any contaminants that may hinder adhesion. Priming may be necessary on porous surfaces.

Limitations

Porous surfaces should be primed first. Do not use on surfaces where water can penetrate through porous materials to the bond interface without first carrying out remedial work. Not suitable for use on natural stone.

Storage & Shelf Life

Store in cool, dry conditions at a temperature between 41°F (5°C) and 77°F (25°C).

Product should be stored in the original, unopened container. Use within 12 months from date of manufacture.

Cleanup

Do not leave empty containers where residue could be harmful to children, animals or the environment. Remove any containers to a central disposal point in accordance with local regulations.

Disposal

Empty containers must be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations. Do not leave empty or partially used containers where residue could be harmful to children, animals, or the environment.
