Bond It All Purpose is a high quality siliconized acrylic sealant for universal applications. It provides a permanent flexible, long-lasting seal which adheres to virtually any material. Contains fungicide to resist mold growth and is paintable.

Product Use

For exterior sealing of wood or metal door and window frames and internal sealing of PVCu frames. Fills gaps and cracks in masonry and can be used as an adhesive for styrofoam crown molding/tiles, cork tiles, and woodblock flooring.


Application / Instructions

Surfaces must be clean, dry and dust/grease-free. Highly porous surfaces should be primed with PVA before application. Remove all existing sealant. Cut the tip of the cartridge without damaging the threaded area. Screw on the nozzle and cut at an angle of 45° to an opening slightly larger than the gap to be sealed. Apply using a standard sealant gun and tool down within 20 minutes of application using the appropriate tool. Can be painted after 1 hour provided surface skin has formed, (24048 hours for oil-based paints).

Surface Preparation

For best results, surface should be clean, dry and structurally sound.

Limitations

When using externally, in areas of high humidity, protect from water for a minimum of 12 hours. In damp and cold conditions, cure time will be significantly extended. Not for use in conjunction with bitumen or asphalt. Do not attempt to abrade when cured. Do not use around baths or shower trays. We recommend use of Bond It S3 SILICONE. Do not over paint until a surface skin has formed. Over painting is not necessary. Note: this product is flexible. Certain poor quality paints (especially certain vinyl matts)have very little movement in the dry film. It is possible for the dry paint film to crack if movement is excessive. Should not be used in conditions of continuous water immersion, below ground level, in areas of high abrasion (eg floor joints). This product is not a silicone sealant and is not suitable for joints with very high movement.

Storage & Shelf Life

Store in cool, dry conditions, protect from frost.

Product should be stored in the original, unopened container. Use within 24 months of date of manufacture.

Cleanup

Clean up excess wet caulk with a damp sponge before it cures. Excess dried caulk must be cut or scraped off. Wash hands and tools with warm water and soap.

Disposal

Empty containers must be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations. Do not leave empty or partially used containers where residue could be harmful to children, animals, or the environment.
