LITTLE MARÍA

When my daughters began grade school and started learning about their friend's families, they came home wanting to learn more about their parents. Our daily conversations turned into a kind of storytelling. My children wanted to know if my husband and I were anything like them when we were little and had similar experiences, primarily since I had grown up in a different country.

Little María was born out of their curiosity. I wanted my daughters to know more about what their mommy was like as a child and what I did for fun growing up in the Dominican Republic. As I shared some of my fondest childhood memories, I was inspired to make it into a book with beautiful illustrations that eventually turned into an animation. I believe kids need to see themselves in books, content, and stories--this natural urge to better understand ourselves inspires learning.

There are too few books, media, and content that speak to our communities. While the Latino student population is rising, they don't see themselves in their curriculum materials and other classroom resources.

I wanted to do something for my daughters to see themselves! Storytelling helps keep our culture alive, and I'm grateful to be part of a broader community of creators developing content for children to be seen and inspire future generations.

Little María is reminiscent of my childhood. It is a one-of-a-kind, but I've come to learn that it has an international reach because so many children in immigrant families can relate to my experiences. It inspires children to learn from each other and even motivates them to learn about their own families' upbringing/culture.

María is not just a foreigner, and she's a child that enjoys spending quality time with her family, friends, and community.
