Power On Dash Cam powers ON when the engine is turned on. Alternatively, press and hold the power button for more than 3 seconds to power on the Dash Cam.	Blue LED light stays on when Dash Cam is powering on.
Power Off Dash Cam powers OFF when the engine is turned off. Alternatively, press and hold the power button for more than 3 seconds to power OFF the Dash Cam.	Blue LED light turns off when the Dash Cam is powering off and not charging. Blue LED light turns off and Red LED light stays on when the Dash Cam is powering off and charging.
Standby Mode	Solid Blue LED light.
Park & Record Mode	Blue LED light flashes.
Firmware Upgrade	Solid Red and Blue LED lights.

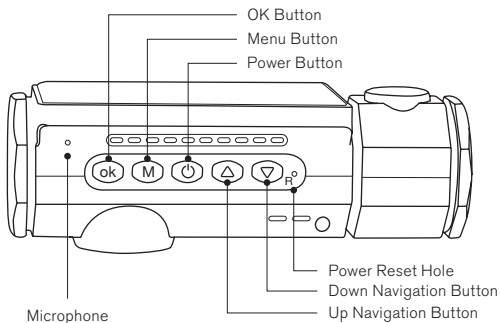

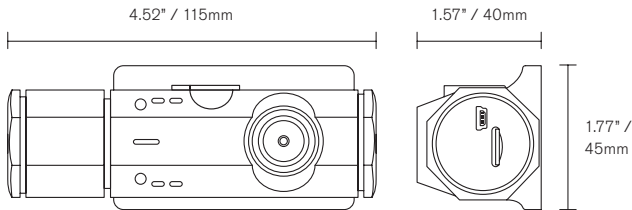

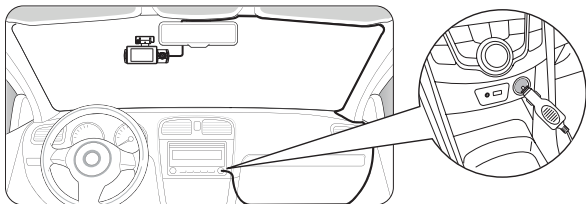


Mount the Dash Cam to the windshield. You can turn on the Dash Cam and check the live screen to determine the most suitable mounting position.

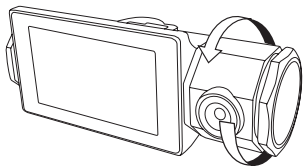
Warning: Do not install the product in a location where it can obstruct the driver's field of vision.

Route and hide the power cable in the headliner and pillars in your vehicle. Plug the cigarette lighter adapter into your vehicle's 12/24V DC outlet.







Adjust the rear camera lens angle to get the best interior view.


CONFIGURATION & MENU SETTINGS

Switching views

Press the  key to cycle through the following views: front view > rear view > dual view with rear view in small picture > dual view with front view in small picture > dual view with split screen.




Video mode

- This is the default recording setting. The camera will start recording automatically once it is turned on.
- Press the  key to switch between different modes, until the  icon appears on the upper left corner of the screen.
- Press the  button to start recording, a flashing red dot will appear on the screen indicating the Dash Cam is recording.
- Files are looped or recorded over by the default of 1 minute. The MicroSD card will hold 1 minute segments and record over them as space is needed.
- Video files recorded by the front lens are saved under folder "DCIMA".
- Video files recorded by the rear lens are saved under folder "DCIMB".
- Stop Loop Video: Press the  button to pause recording.









Note: The Dash Cam will not record automatically when you switch back to video mode from other shooting modes. You need to press the  key manually to start recording.

G-Sensor Setting: The camera's integrated G-Sensor will automatically save and lock the recorded file if activated by an impact event or accident. Select the sensitivity of the G-Sensor: Off, Low, Medium, or High. The default sensitivity setting is Medium.

Photo mode

- Press the  key to switch between different modes, until you see the  icon appears on the upper left corner of the screen.
- Press the  button each time you want to take a picture.
- Image files recorded by the front lens are saved under folder "DCIMA".
- Image files recorded by the rear lens are saved under folder "DCIMB".

Playback mode

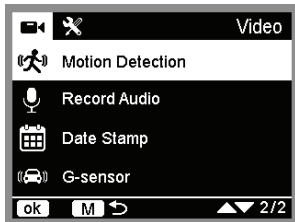
- Press the  key to switch between different modes, until you see the  or  icon appear on the upper left corner of the screen.
- Press the  and  button to cycle through all the media files.
- Press the  key to play video files and press it again to pause.
- Press the  or  button during a video file is playing to adjust the volume.

Video settings

- Press the **(ok)** button when the Dash Cam is recording in video mode in order to stop recording and then press and hold the **(M)** button to enter video settings.
- In the video setting page, press **(△)** or **(▽)** to switch between selections and press **(ok)** to confirm selection.



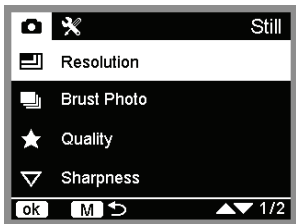
- **Resolution:** Select between FHD 1920x1080 or HP 1280x720.
- **Loop Recording:** Select between 5 minutes, 3 minutes or 1 minute.
- **WDR:** Select between ON or OFF.
- **Exposure:** Select between -2.0, -1.7, -1.3, -1.0, -0.7, -0.3, 0, +0.3, +0.7, +1.0, +1.7 or +2.0.



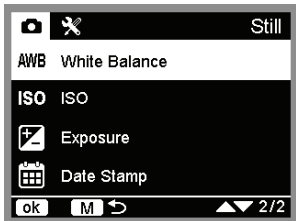
- **Motion Detection:** Select between ON or OFF.
- **Record Audio:** Select between ON or OFF.
- **Date Stamp:** Select between ON or OFF.
- **G-Sensor:** Select between High, Medium, Low, or OFF.

Camera settings

- Press and hold the (M) button in the photo mode to enter camera settings.
- In the camera setting page, press (▲) or (▼) to switch between selections and press (OK) to confirm selection.



- **Resolution:** Select between 12M (4032x3024), 10M (3648x2736), 8M (3264x2448), 5M (2592x1944), 3M (2048x1536), 2MHD (1920x1080), 1.3M (1280x960) or VGA (640x480).
- **Quality:** Select between Fine, Normal or Economy.
- **Sharpness:** Select between Strong, Normal or Soft.



- **White Balance:** Select between Auto, Daylight, Cloudy, Tungsten or Fluorescent.
- **ISO:** Select between 100, 200, 300, 400 or Auto.
- **Exposure:** Select between -2.0, -1.7, -1.3, -1.0, -0.7, -0.3, 0, +0.3 or +2.0.
- **Date Stamp:** Select between Date and Time, Date Only or OFF.

Playback settings

- Press and hold the **(M)** button in the playback mode to enter playback settings.
- In the playback setting page, press **(△)** or **(▽)** to switch between selections and press **(ok)** to confirm selection.

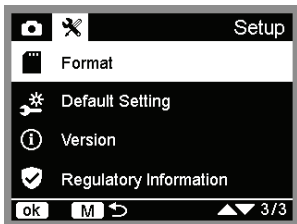
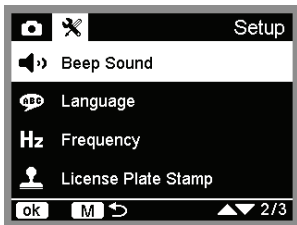


- **Delete:** Select to delete the file.
- **Protect:** Select to protect the file from deletion.

Note: If you use your own MicroSD card please insert it into the Dash Cam and use the format function under general setting page (refer to page 16) before first use.



Dash Cam general settings

- Press **(M)** once in either video, camera or playback setting page to enter the general setting pages.
- In the general setting pages, press **(Δ)** or **(▽)** to switch between selections and press **(ok)** to confirm selection.

- **Parking Monitor:** Select the level of sensitivity between High, Medium, Low or Off.
- **Date/Time:** Set the date and time.
- **Auto Power Off:** Select between 1 min, 3 min, 5 min or Off.
- **Screensavers:** Select between 1 min, 3 min, 5 min or Off.
- **Beep Sound:** Select between On or Off.
- **Language:** Supports English only.
- **Frequency:** Select between 50Hz or 60Hz.
- **License Plate Stamp:** Enter your vehicle license plate number here.
- **Format:** Select to erase all data in the MicroSD card.
- **Default Setting:** Reset all the settings to their defaults.
- **Version:** Firmware version.
- **Display Regulatory Information**

SPECIAL FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION

Automatic ON / OFF

When the Dash Cam is connected to the vehicle's power, it will power on and start recording when the vehicle engine starts. When the engine is off, the Dash Cam will stop recording and turn off automatically.

Gravity induction

In case of vehicle collision, the Dash Cam will lock the broken video of the accident and save it as a special image. At the same time, the icon of the lock will be displayed in the middle of the display screen. The locked image will not be covered by loops.

Note: The G-Sensor supports sensitivity adjustment and it can be done in the video setting page according to actual needs.

Park & Record function

The Park & Record function allows the Dash Cam to record videos when it detects any vibration when the vehicle's engine is off. Refer to page 16 on setting up the parking monitor. The Dash Cam will turn on automatically and record a 30 seconds video clip and then shutdown; when it detects another vibration, it will do the same thing again.

Note: The Dash Cam will switch to Park & Record mode only when the vehicle's engine is turned off. The Dash Cam will not switch to Park & Record mode if it is turned off completely by pressing the power button for more than 3 seconds.

Battery indications:

Note: The Dash Cam is designed to follow the vehicle running for a long time. The built-in battery is only designed for storing documents when the vehicle's engine is off. The working time of the fixed battery is limited. Please connect the Dash Cam to the vehicle's on-board power supply in daily use.

There are 2 ways to charge the Dash Cam's battery. The red charge indicator lights up during the charging process. The whole charging time is about 180 minutes. The red charge indicator lights will turn off automatically when charging is done.

- 1: Use the cigarette lighter adapter (CLA) to charge.
- 2: Charge with 5V USB power supply in your car (with the MiniUSB to USB charging cable provided).

Camera Reset: If the camera is involved in an accident and requires reset, simply turn off and turn back on the camera.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Under normal operation, if there is a problem, please refer to the solutions below.

- 1) Problem: The Dash Cam is unable to take pictures and record videos.
Solution: Check if the MicroSD card has enough space and lock it.
- 2) Problem: The Dash Cam stops automatically when it is recording a video.
Solution: Because HD video data takes a lot of space, please use a high-speed MicroSD card compatible with SDHC, high-speed MicroSD cards will have C10 logo.
- 3) Problem: During the playback of pictures and videos, a "file error" message prompts.
Solution: When a MicroSD card storage error or incomplete file occurred, please use the camera's "format" function to reformat the MicroSD card (refer to page 16).
- 4) Problem: The image looks foggy.
Solution: Please check whether there is dirt or fingerprint on the lens. Clean the lens using lens cleaner or lens wiper before using.
- 5) Problem: The image looks too dark.
Solution: If the Dash Cam captures an image that is too dark, adjust the exposure level to bump up the brightness (refer to page 14).

- Never depend on the Karaoke Dash Cam entirely when driving. The image on the screen is different from actual conditions. Objects viewed in the Dash Monitor differ from actual distance because a wide-angle lens is used.
- The Karaoke Dash Cam “night vision” feature that is high performance brightness with colorful image is an aid to a driver but is limited. Always use your own eyes to confirm the vehicle’s surroundings, as the displayed image may be faint or dark, distorted, or not entirely visible.
- Always check behind and all around the vehicle visually with mirrors before proceeding.
- The area displayed by the Karaoke Dash Cam is limited. The Karaoke Dash Cam does not display objects that are out of the Camera’s field of view. The area displayed on the screen may vary according to vehicle orientation or road conditions.
- Be sure to check the Camera’s position and mounting angle before each use.
- Do not strike the Karaoke Dash Cam. It is a precision instrument. Otherwise, it may malfunction or cause damage resulting in a fire or an electric shock.
- This product will only provide images of items that are within the field of view of the Karaoke Dash Cam. Thus, it is imperative that the Karaoke Dash Cam should be kept clean and unobstructed.
- Adhere to all applicable traffic laws and motor vehicle regulations

applicable to the device.

- Consult local laws and regulations for any restrictions on installation or use.
- Never allow children to play with the device. Small parts may be a choking hazard.
- There is a plastic cover over the Karaoke Dash Cam. Do not scratch the cover when cleaning dirt or snow from the cover.
- If the temperature changes rapidly, the system may not operate normally.
- When strong light directly enters a camera, objects may not be displayed clearly.
- The screen may flicker under fluorescent light.
- The colors of objects on the Karaoke Dash Cam may differ from those of the actual object.
- Do not use alcohol, benzene or thinner to clean the Camera. This will cause discoloration. To clean the camera, wipe with a clean cloth dampened with mild cleaner diluted with water and then wipe with a dry cloth.

Safety Around and Behind Other Vehicles

Using a Karaoke Dash Cam is not enough to completely overcome a vehicle's blind spot. Many preventable injuries and deaths occur in driveways or parking lots when drivers do not see children, pets, or others near their vehicles. Here are a few safety tips that will help you to avoid a back-over accident:

- Walk completely around your vehicle before getting in. Check for kids, toys, and pets before entering the vehicle and starting the engine.
- Know where children are. Have children stand in a place where they are in full view.
- Be aware of young children. Young children are small and hard to see.
- Parents, caregivers and all adults need to be vigilant in supervising

children, especially when children are in the yard, driveway or parking lot playing near parked cars.

- Roll down your window so you will be able to hear what is happening outside your vehicle.
- Owners of SUVs, trucks, and vans need to take extra care to avoid hitting or running over a child.
- Teach children to move away from a vehicle whenever it is started.

Cleaning

- If dirt, rain or snow attaches to the Camera, the Monitor may not clearly display objects. If water droplets, snow or mud adhere to the Camera lens, rinse with water and wipe with a dry cloth.
- Do not use alcohol, benzene or thinner to clean the Camera. This will cause discoloration. To clean the Camera, wipe with a clean cloth dampened with mild cleaner diluted with water and then wipe with a dry cloth.
