Required Records



A full set of standard photos (3 facial, 5 intraoral) and X-rays (Pano/Ceph) taken within 4 weeks before or 2 weeks after the scan. The "Full Mouth" photo is strongly recommended.

Frontal



- Patient looking forward.
- Head leveled.
- Lips together & relaxed
- Capture collarbone, top of head, ears must be visible.

Profile



- Hair behind ears
- Head leveled.
- Lips together & relaxed
- Capture collarbone, top of head, ears must be visible.

Frontal Smile



- Patients true bite
- Patients natural smile
- Patient looking forward.
- Head leveled.
- Capture collarbone, top of head, ears must be visible.

Upper Occlusal



- Use articulating paper.
- Take photo of reflection in mirror
- Rest mirror behind lower molars

Full Mouth



- Slightly open to see incisal edges.
- Capture 2nd molar to 2nd molar

Lower Occlusal



- Use articulating paper.
- Take photo of reflection in mirror
- Retract tongue with mirror.
- Rest mirror behind lower molars

Right Buccal



- Capture class relation of bite
- Straight shot cuspid to molar
- Capture 1st cusp tip of 2nd molar
- Use buccal mirrors if necessary.

Center



- Teeth in occlusion
- Equal display of the posterior dentition
- Midline centered and occlusal plane bisecting photograph.

Left Buccal



- Capture class relation of bite
- Straight shot cuspid to molar
- Capture 1st cusp tip of 2nd molar
- Use buccal mirrors if necessary.
