INSTRUCTIONS

1. Form A shall be used where the data subject wishes to object to the processing of his or her personal data, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, in any of the following situations:

The processing of your personal data is being carried out on the basis of a public interest mission or in the exercise of public powers vested in the controller.

The processing of my personal data is being carried out on the basis of the satisfaction of legitimate interests pursued by the controller or a third party.

In these first two cases, the mere exercise of the right of opposition entails the limitation of the right to object.

The processing of my personal data is being carried out for scientific or historical research or statistical purposes.

Form B. shall be used where the data subject wishes to object to the processing of his or her personal data for direct marketing purposes, including profiling.

- 2. It will be necessary to provide a photocopy of the ID card or equivalent document that proves the identity and is considered valid in law, in those cases in which the person responsible has doubts about his identity. In the event of acting through legal representation, the ID card and document accrediting the representation of the representative must also be provided.
- 3.
