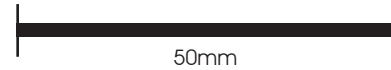

FIND YOUR RING SIZE

IMPORTANT

1. Open on your screen and place your ruler on the bar to the right.
2. You can check the page is true to size by measuring the bar. It should be exactly 50mm.



HOW TO MEASURE FOR YOUR RING SIZE

You will need:

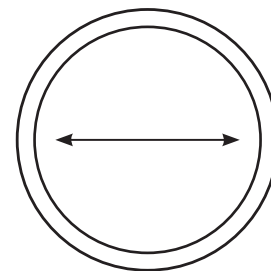
- A computer, tablet or mobile screen
- A ruler
- A ring that fits the finger you intend to buy for

Steps:

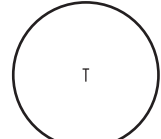
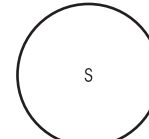
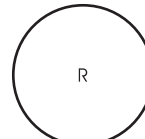
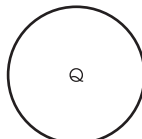
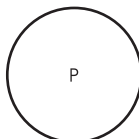
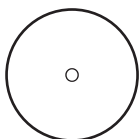
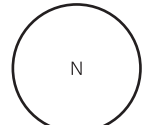
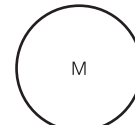
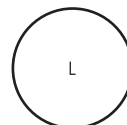
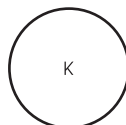
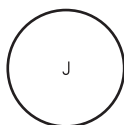
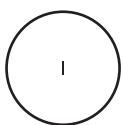
1. Choose a ring that you already own that perfectly fits the finger you intend to buy for.
2. Place this ring over the circles below to find your best fit.
3. Match the inside edge of your ring to the circle nearest in size. This will give you the internal diameter of the ring and your ring size.
4. If you find that the ring fits two circles, opt for the smaller size.
5. Don't forget! Most of our rings can be resized to fit.
