

What happens in *The Golden Cage*

This European fairy tale tells the story of Valentina, a very spoilt princess who lives in the Emperor's palace. She's obsessed with collecting rare and exotic birds and sends her servants on long missions to find them from around the world. Now, she is determined to find a talking bird to fill her special golden cage. Servant after servant loses their head for coming back empty handed. That is, until one day a mysterious young man claims he can fulfil Valentina's impossible request. He brings back the egg of the mysterious talking bird. Valentina waits and waits for the egg to hatch. How did her story end? No one truly knows...






What do you think the egg of the talking bird looked like? Make a tiny egg using clay, plasticine or playdough. Make a little nest for it and a box to put it in.
