**WOOLITE BLACK OR WOOLITE FOR DARKS  
IS THE DETERGENT OF CHOICE FOR  
WASHING YOUR

**FILL TUB WITH COLD WATER, ADD A CUPFUL  
AND GET SOME BUBBLE ACTION GOING,  
JUST HIGH ENOUGH TO COVER  
YOUR CIVILIANAIRES.**



**TAKE YOUR CIVILIANAIRE GOLD SELVAGE JEANS, THAT SHOULD HAVE BEEN WORN EVERY DAY FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS OR MORE, AND SUBMERGE THEM IN THE TUB.**



**IF THEY FLOAT TO THE SURFACE,  
HOLD THEM DOWN WITH FILLED PLASTIC  
CONTAINERS YOU PROBABLY  
HAVE UNDER THE SINK.**



**LEAVE SOAKING FOR 45 MINUTES TO 1 HOUR.  
THAT NASTY COLOR IS ALL THE DIRT,  
GRIME, AND SWEAT FLOATING AWAY,  
ALONG WITH A LITTLE INDIGO.**



**DRAIN AND FILL AGAIN WITH COLD WATER  
AND RINSE UNTIL

**HANG THEM ON
