To bind your book w/
string:

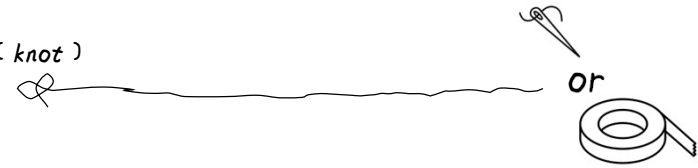


1. Stack both sheets on a
dishcloth.



2. Use a sharp pen or skewer to
poke out the holes.

(knot)



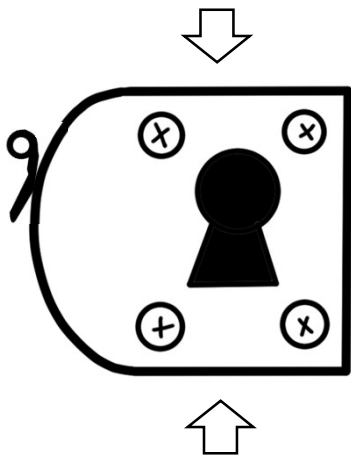
3. Tie a knot in one end of a
10" piece of yarn or string and
wrap the other end in a small
piece of tape. Start from the
circle page of your book and
follow the pattern of drawn
thread on the outside cover.

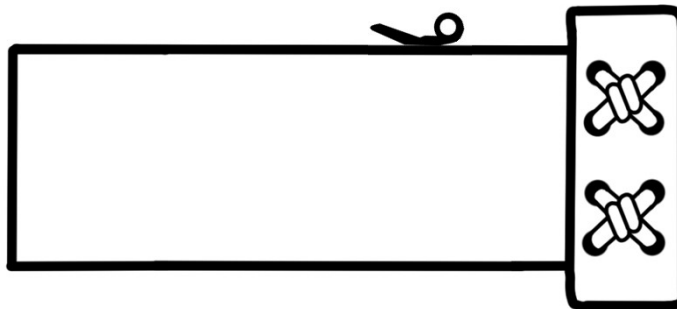

If you want to add a little extra flourish...

cut out the items below to create a closure mechanism.



Place the keyhole
to the left on top
of the keyhole on
the book, apply
clear tape where
arrows indicate.
Leave the sides
untaped to allow
the strap to fit
underneath.



Place the strap holder
to the left on top
of the strap holder
on the back of the
book. You can either tape
over the two X's or you
can sew them the same way
that you sewed the binding.
(Note: if you choose to sew, you will
see exposed thread/yarn on the
heart page of your book.)
