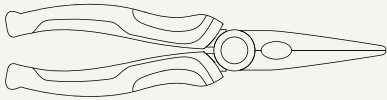


## Tools required



Needle nose pliers



Philips head screwdriver

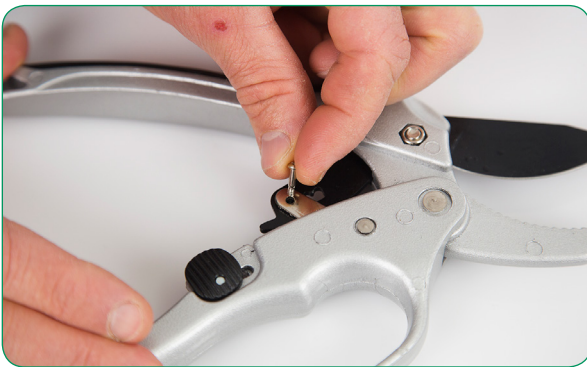


## Step 1:

The Replacement Pin arrives connected so start by unscrewing the nut from the pin.

## Step 2:

Slide the pin into the ratchet slot that holds the blade and handle together.



## Step 3:

Screw the nut on with your fingers.



## Step 4:

Use needle nose pliers to hold the nut in place.



## Step 5:

Turn the pruners over and use a philips head screwdriver to tighten the screw.
