Off-licence

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **GLADSTONE VINEYARD LIMITED** is authorised to sell alcohol from the premises **known as Gladstone Vineyard** situated at 340 Gladstone Road, Carterton 5792, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day;
2. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made on the premises
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday from 9.00am to 7.00pm
4. The licensee must display signage as follows:
 - I. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - II. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering the principal entrance to the premise; and
 - III. A sign prominently displayed, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
 - IV. **Potable drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample at the place where the samples are being supplied.**

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

(a) Until its expiry date detailed below; OR (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period of 3 years after the expiry date.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on: **21th March 2020**
