



## JANTZ HARDENED FILE GUIDE

The Jantz Hardened File Guide keeps your blade, guard or other material in place as you work. Useful for maintaining level edges and symmetry on plunge and grind lines, squaring shoulders of hidden tang blades, filing slots for guards, and much more. Precision ground from A2 Tool Steel and hardened to 62RHc for long wear. Users should avoid grinding or filing directly on the surface to maintain the precision grind and surface.

	
<p>Bottom section of the Jantz file guide is countersunk on one side to allow for narrow or wide opening of the jaws. Simply flip the bottom side to adjust for narrow or wider parts. Use 1/8" Hex Wrench</p>	<p>Align material to be filed with surface of the file guide to assure lines are even and symmetrical.</p>
<p>Work parallel to the surface of the file guide for even, level, filing.</p> <p>We recommend use the 'push technique' of pushing the file across the material, lifting from the surface, retract to start and then repeat. This allows the chip to clear and not be dragged back into the work area.</p> <p>For angled file work, we recommend an adjustable vise to hold the file guide at multiple angles while working.
