

### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PART NO. 19873**

# **Installation Instructions:**

- 1. Disconnect the passanger side negative battery cable and remove the drivers side battery
- 2. Pull the filter minder out of the factory air box
- Remove the factory ATS sensor by twisting and pulling stright out
- 4. Loosen the clamp holding the air duct into the turbo inlet pipe
- 5. Remove the (4) bolts holding the factory air box down
- 6. Pull up on the factory air box and remove it from the engine compartment
- 7. Remove the factory battery tray
- 8. Press the factory fresh air piping into the volant box
- 9. Press the 231/2in trim to the large oval port on the side of the air box
- Press the 161/2in trim around the round hole in the volant box
- 11. Attach the volant battery tray to the volant box usint the hardware provided
- Place the volant box into factory position and bolt the battery tray to the fenderwell using the factory bolts
- 13. Twist the ATS sensor into the medal ring in the back of the volant box
- 14. Press the filter minder into the rubber grommet on the volant box
- 15. Attach the 4 x 2 1/2 sleeve onto the turbo inlet pipe and attach it with a #64 clamp
- 16. Slide the duct through the air box lid and out the round hole and ABOVE the inlet opening
- 17. Place the volant filter into the volant box and slide the air duct into the the filter and tighten the filter clamp. Slide the duct into the sleeve and tighten the #64 clamp
- Attach the volant air box lid and tighten with the (4) truss head screws
- Reinstall the battery and tighten down with the factory hold down hardware
- 20. Reattach the negative battery cable

WARNING: OVER TIGHTENING HARDWARE MAY ALTAR THE INTEGRITY OF THE VOLANT AIR INTAKE SYSTEM.

#### **BEFORE ROAD TESTING**

- 1. Start engine, leaving the transmission in park and securing the parking brake.
- Make sure to look and listen for any unusual noises or air leaks. Repair problems if needed.
- Once completed it will be necessary to check periodically for realignment and tightening of all connections.
- Once all tests are completed, enjoy the performance of your new Volant Air Intake System.

#### **CARE AND CLEANING**

Check the cotton reusable filter periodically and remove any excessive dirt build-up by tapping the filter on the ground and brushing off the loosened dirt. Clean the filter by using Volant's Filter Recharger Kit. Volant's Filter Recharger Kit is designed to restore original air flow. Re-oil every 10,000 miles without cleaning to improve filtering in sand and dirt. Clean only when dirt is very excessive or 50,000 miles.
