

## **Hanger Bracket Bracing**







## Notes on suspension bracing:

- 1. Do not exceed the load capacity of the suspension. That is the trailer weight measured at the ground.
- 2. Read the maintenance and installation manual before installation.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure proper vehicle frame design in the area of the suspension attachment.
- 4. Cross members are required at hanger and airbag locations, diagrams shown are for reference purposes only. Frame design is the responsibility of the installer.
- 5. Locate cross bracing as shown in Fig 1 or Fig 2 as above.
- 6. Min 35mm clearance is required around the airbag in the installed position
- 7. Min 30mm clearance is required above the tyre to any trailer component with the suspension at full compression.
- 8. Min 50mm from any trailer component to the tyre, Installer to ensure no fowl conditions as suspension does experience some lateral movement
