Prescription Guidelines

Veterinarians: You are responsible for determining the oxygen flow rate based on the delivery method, animal weight, and desired inspired concentration. While Pawprint Oxygen provides guidelines (see chart below), it is the attending veterinarian's responsibility to determine dosage and oxygen flow rate.

Portable Oxygen Kit

A portable supply of oxygen for use at home and during transport. Each Kit includes Pawprint Oxygen Canisters, Regulator, PureVent Mask and Tubing.

Standard Kits:

Dog 22-33 lb	Large	0.2 LPM	45 min	
Dog 33+ lb	Large	0.3 LPM	30 min	

The **Flow Rate** for standard kits is based on a dosage of 100 ml/kg/min. The Regulator is factory-set to the prescribed flow rate and cannot be changed by the client.

The Duration of the kit can be increased by purchasing additional Pawprint Oxygen Canisters, which contain 15 liters of oxygen (99%) each.

The Mask refers to the PureVent Pet Oxygen Mask, which is included in all kits.

Custom Kits: Write in the flow rate (0.5,1.0, 2.0, or 3.0 LPM). The maximum flow rate is 3.0 LPM. If you wish to prescribe a higher flow rate, please consider an Oxygen Concentrator. For custom kits, the correct Mask size will be provided by our experts based on the pet.

Extended Oxygen Therapy

Oxygen Concentrators may be used for pets that require more than one hour of therapy per day or pets requiring higher flow rates than can be achieved with Oxygen Canisters. Concentrators may be used in tandem with a

The Concentrator is available in two models:

- 5 Liter: Adjustable flow rate from 1-5 LPM
- 10 Liter: Adjustable flow rate from 2-10 LPM

Oxygen Tents are available in the following sizes:

- Small (10" x 8" x 8"): Rabbits / exotics
- Medium (20" x 13" x 14"): Cats / small dogs.
- Large (31" x 21" x 24"): Middle sized dogs.

To achieve sufficient oxygen saturation levels::

- Use a 5 Liter Concentrator to supply oxygen to a Small or Medium Tent.
- Use a 10 Liter Concentrator to supply oxygen to a Large Tent

Note: Pawprint Oxygen Canisters cannot be used to supply Oxygen Tent due to flow rate requirements.
