Parasol Information

Please do read the following :-

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The warranty and/or guarantee issued with your parasol does not cover damage caused by misuse or wind damage.

The client and/or user of the parasol is/are solely responsible for familiarising themselves with the product and ensuring that the parasol is used safely.

Parasols are primarily sunshades and are not designed for any cover or protection against wind or rain.

Parasols above 1.5m x 1.5m are particularly susceptible to movement and even flight if in the open position in windy or open environments.

If the conditions are such that a parasol is disturbed by wind, then it should be closed immediately.

When open, parasols should never be left unattended for long periods of time or left overnight without closing.

In the case of a parasol being used on a level above ground floor and without a fixed and secure anchor, it is solely the responsibility of the client/user to ensure that adequate ballast is employed prior to using the parasol.

Extra care must be taken for any parasols positioned in exposed landscapes and on roof gardens or roof terraces, In these circumstances the parasol must be secured by mechanical means to prevent accidents and the possible consequences of a parasol in flight.
