FEATURES & INSTRUCTIONS

1. Safely plug brush into an electrical outlet. 2. Turn on by pressing and holding the "ON" button for about 3 - 5 seconds. The "ON" button is located on the right hand side of the brushes' handle. The brush is on when the temperature reading display lights up. 3. Select desired temperature based on hair type. 4. Please refer this Personalized Heat Temperature Chart:

PHT CHART

Low: 320° - 360°F 160° - 180°C	Straight- Wavy - Fine - Chemically Treated - Heat Damage - Bonds - Tape
Medium: 360° - 400°F 180° - 205°C	Wavy - Curly - Medium - Chemically Treated - Heat Damage - Micro Beads
High: 400° - 450°F 205° - 230°C	Wavy - Curly - Medium - Coarse - Virgin - Sewn-in - Micro Beads

5. Set temperature by pressing the "+" or "-" buttons, located on the right hand side of the brushes' handle. 6. Check temperature reading display to ensure desired temperature has been reached. This could take up to two minutes. Once desired temperature has been reached, recovery time on this brush is immediate so the temperature will remain even while in use.

7. On dry hair, take a section and run straightening brush from roots to ends with a slow downward motion. Make sure that the section of hair penetrates deep in to the bristles of the brush. Brushing at a slow pace will ensure the correct amount of heat is absorbed throughout the section, making it easier to straighten. 8. Take sections that feel comfortable to manage, do not

take sections that are too large, as the heat won't be able to penetrate deeply and evenly 9. Don't be afraid to run the brush close to the scalp. The

10. We recommend paying attention to the following areas

Roots: This is where volume is added or reduced depending on hair type. To add volume at the roots, place straightening brush at a 90-degree angle from the roots and brush up and away from the scalp. To decrease volume, brush hair down and close to the scalp.


Mid-strand: This is where hair texture is the most resistant, especially on course, curly hair. If too much resistant texture is encountered, we recommend multiple passes only to that area of the hair, or setting the temperature

Ends: This is where hair tends to be the most sensitive to heat. We recommend fewer passes and, if needed, lower

11. As a safety measure, we recommend checking twice if the straightening brush has been turned off correctly. After finishing styling hair, press and hold the "ON" button until the temperature reading display is completely off; and only then will it be safe to unplug straightening brush. 12. Allow brush to cool completely before storing.

Fahrenheit / Celsius Display: Press the "+" then "-" button in rapid succession to toggle between Fahrenheit and Celsius display.

For your safety, his appliance has an Auto-Shutoff function. If left on, it will automatically shut off after 60 minutes.
