INSTRUCTIONS AND STYLING TIPS

1. Ensure hair is clean and combed through.

- 2. Plug the iron into a current socket of a voltage specified on the rating plate. The 4 power indicator LEDs around the
- on/off button will shine, indicating that the iron is powered.
 3. Turn the iron on by pressing the on/off button at the top of the iron. The blue LED heating indicator, in front of the button will flash intermittently, indicating that the iron is heating up. When the blue LED stops flashing, it indicates that the iron has reached the set temperature.
- 4. Adjust to desired temperature by pressing the same button. This button, cycles through the irons heat settings and turns the iron on and off.
- 5. The iron has 4 heat settings. These are:
- 160°C=320°F, 180°C=360°F, 200°C=390°F, 220°C=430°F.
 6. LEDs on the iron's right side will indicate the temperature setting. The default setting is 430°F/220°C.
- 7. Separate a 2 inch/5cm (maximum) section of hair.
- 8. Place the section of hair between the heating plates close to the roots.
- Hold the hair firmly between the heating plates and slide down the length of hair from root to tip.
- 10. Repeat as necessary.
- 11. Allow the hair to cool before combing through.
 12. After use, turn off the iron by pressing the on/off Button repeatedly, until the Temp Setting and Heating Indicator LEDs are all off. Unplug the iron from the socket. Allow it to cool before storing.

- 2. Plug the flat iron into a current socket of a voltage specified on the rating plate. Turn the flat iron on using the ON/OFF button on the inside of the iron. The red LED will light, indicating power on.
- 3. Adjust to desired temperature by using the turn wheel. The Iron has a temperature range between 180°-450°F or 80°-230°C
- 4. Wait 3 minutes for iron to fully heat before use.
- 5. Separate a 2 inch/5cm (maximum) section of hair.
- Place the section of hair between the heating plates close to the roots.
- 7. Hold the hair firmly between the heating plates and slide down the length of hair from root to tip.
- 8. Repeat as necessary.
- 9. Allow the hair to cool before combing through.

- Ensure hair is dry and combed through.
- 2. Plug the flat iron into a current socket of a voltage specified on the rating plate.
- 3.Turn the flat iron on using the ON/OFF button on the inside of the iron. The LED will light, indicating power on.
 (Wait 3 minutes for iron to fully heat before use.)
- 4. Separate a 2 inch/5cm (maximum) section of hair.
- 5. Place the section of hair between the heating plates close to the roots.
- 6. Hold the hair firmly between the heating plates and slide down the length of hair from root to tip.
- 7. Repeat as necessary.
- 8. Allow the hair to cool before combing through.
- After use turn off the iron using the ON/OFF button and unplug from socket.
- 10. Allow the iron to cool before storing.

Note: Plates of vibrating flat iron oscillate when they are closed together.

- 3. The iron has an Auto-Shut-Off feature set for 30 minutes. This setting can be changed by pressing the power button quickly until the number 30 appears. The time can then be adjusted using the (+) and (-) buttons. 120 minutes is the
- max time. If the time is set to 0, the Auto-Shut-Off is disabled. If the Auto-Shut- Off feature is on, "min" is
- displayed. If "min" does not appear, Auto-Shut-Off is off.
- 4. You can toggle the display between Celcius and Fahrenheit by quickly pressing the power button.
- 5. Adjust the iron to the desired temperature using the (+) and (-) buttons. The maximum temp setting is 232°C or
- 6. Press and hold the power button to turn the iron on.
- 7. Memory Feature: The iron will store your user settings. When next used, your selected settings will resume.
