

Fitting Instructions for the Toyota Prado 150 2nd Row Neoprene Seat Cover

Please read this document in its entirety prior to fitting the seat cover. If you have any specific questions or troubles fitting the seat cover, please contact us first, as we are more than willing to assist with any enquiry



Step 1) Push the front seats as far forward to the front of the vehicle, to ensure an easier fitment of the 2^{nd} Row seat cover.

Step 2) Remove all 3 headrests by pressing the button and lifting the headrest out completely.



Step 3) Turn the neoprene headrest cover inside out and place on the headrest.





Step 4) Roll the headrest cover onto the headrest (the headrest cover should no longer be inside out). The 'Feature thread' should be facing the front of the vehicle. The back sewn thread facing the rear – As per the photos to the left.



Step 5) Secure the touch tape tabs



| Step 11) Carefully tuck the neoprene between the gap of the backrest and the cushion. This will be used to join the touch tape on the other side of the backrest. Note: It is much easier to tuck the material through the gap when the backrest is lowered to a 60-degree angle. |
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| Step 12) Remove the protective touch tape, to allow both touch tapes (from different sections) to join together. Ensure that all holes and provisions on the back of the cover are correctly lined up, so that the backrest can function as normal. You can now raise the backrest to its original, upright position. Note: Please don't throw away the removed protective touch tape, as it will be necessary to keep in the event that you remove the seat covers – Further details included in 'Removal of the Seat Cover – Special Considerations' |
| Step 13) Passenger Side Backrest Fitment – Please follow the drivers side backrest fitment steps. Please Note: Some steps will not be applicable due to the different seat cover design for the Passenger side section. Step 14) Centre Armrest fitment – Lower the centre armrest to a 45 degree angle Step 15) Fit cover over centre armrest and secure the touch tape tabs together. |

| Step 16) 60% Cushion Fitment - |
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| PLEASE NOTE: The cushion section |
| does not lift. Place the seat cover over |
| the cushion section. |
| Step 17) The cover will be secured by |
| affixing the touch tape to the carpet at |
| the back of the 2 nd row seat. You can |
| do this by tucking the neoprene |
| through the gap of the cushion and the |
| backrest section (it is easiest to push |
| through the gap when the backrest is |
| completely lowered flat as there is a |
| larger gap). It is imperative that the |
| cushion cover is aligned correctly |
| prior to removing the protective touch |
| tape. Once satisfied with the fitment of |
| the cushion cover, remove the |
| protective touch tape and then affix |
| the touch tape to the carpet. |
| Step 18) 40% Cushion Fitment - |
| Please follow the 60% cushion fitment |
| steps. |

Removal of the Seat Cover - Special Considerations

- 1) Removal of the headrest cover Simply follow Steps 5, 4, 3 and 2 (in this order). Once removed, please ensure that touch tape tabs are then secured This will prevent any damage / fraying of threads, as a result of the touch tape sticking to the thread.
- 2) Removal of the backrest and cushion cover Once completely removed, re-attach touch tape tabs that were removed. This will prevent any damage / fraying of threads, as a result of the touch tape sticking to the threads on the seat cover

On-going Maintenance / Care Instructions

- 1) Please use a warm cloth to remove any dirt or grime from the seat cover. Please then allow the seat cover to naturally dry.
- 2) Although our seat covers are incredibly durable, Global Automotive Accessories does not recommend that you vacuum your seat covers. Regular vacuuming over time, may compromise the strength of the seat cover. Please use other suitable methods (such as a dustpan) to remove excessive dust, dog hair etc.

Warranty Claims

Warranty claims are valid for 6 months and will only be accepted if the material or sewing is found to be defective. Photographic evidence must be provided prior to any goods being returned to Global Automotive Accessories for a warranty claim. Failure to follow the fitting instructions will void any warranty claims. Although the material is durable and stretchable in nature, if the cover is fitted too aggressively, like all materials it can tear. Please ensure that the covers are fitted gently and with care.
