The role looks after a team of 5 and feeds into the Senior Leadership Team.

With big ambitions for growth over the next few years in the UK, and potentially abroad, the role will be focussed on successfully executing plans from an operational perspective whilst managing the environmental impact to ensure we are growing in a responsible way.

In a nutshell, you are responsible for:

- Lead and develop a best in class operations team— this role has a growing team of five with four direct reports who include: Supply Chain Manager, Demand Planning Manager, Demand Planner, Supply Chain Exec & Product Technologist
- Long term strategy Setting and delivering upon the long term three year strategy and direction for our supply chain.
- CLOGS Management Managing and reporting on the annual operations budget including monthly & quarterly COGs and LOGs analysis, operational expenses and risk and ops profile
- KPI & Service Level Management and reporting of the operational key performance indicators for the business that include customer service level, OTIF, complaints, forecast accuracy, and factory performance
- S&OP Overall responsibility for Sales & Operation monthly process (S&OP) by working closely with the sales and finance team
- Procurement Responsible for overall procurement & future planning for key commodities in particular peanuts and almonds
- Stakeholder management the lead for all key manufacturing partners and suppliers as well as responsibility for all operational contracts
- Accountability for all operational and innovation projects- from new innovation to supply chain efficiencies you will lead your team to ensure all aspects of projects are delivered to on time and to budget
- Technical Lead- Accountability for Technical and quality across our product ranges and supporting the Product team from an Operations perspective that we're continuously improving our products
- Sustainability Lead Operations lead on all environmental initiatives and relevant B-corp objectives.
