Safety Instructions


CAUTION READ BEFORE USE

WARNING: Risk of scalding. High water temperatures can cause severe burns. Set the valve water temperature at or below 120°F (49°C). Refer to the temperature adjustment instructions for the valve.

- Follow all local plumbing and building codes.
- The filter cartridge has a limited service life dependent on usage.
 Changes in taste, odor, and/or flow of the water being filtered indicate that the filter cartridge should be replaced.


- Water temperatures above 100°F / 38°C or water pressure above 110
 PSI may damage the filter
- Choking Hazard! This product contains small and/or detachable parts which are a choking hazard.
- Keep away from children and pets.





Installation With Attachment Bands







Step 1

Choose attachment band closest to spout size. Slide band onto the bathtub spout. Position it near the end where the spout cover will sit. The band should be snug but not too stretched out.

Step 2

Attach the Spout Cover.

Press the spout cover firmly onto the bathtub spout, over the attachment band. The band will help hold the cover in place securely.

Step 2

Align the Spout. Make sure the spout is centered over the filter opening and filter is level. (It's fine if the spout cover doesn't sit flush against the wall.)


*The Filter is already installed inside the Spout Cover. If you notice some residual black carbon around the filter cartridge, this is normal.

Filling your Bathtub



Start Slow


Gently turn on the water. It should flow smoothly through the filter.



Adjust Pressure

If the water comes out too fast for the filter, you'll see it spilling from the small overflow hole.

Just turn the pressure down a bit to keep it flowing through the filter.




Adjust Temperature

Important: Avoid using very hot water, as it can damage the filter.

If temperature indicator turns white, the water temperature is too hot.


Filter Replacement

Change the Filter Every 3 Months




Step 1

Use the finger slot to gently pull out the old filter from the bottom of the spout cover.



Step 2

Throw away the old filter, then take the new filter and place it in with the flat side facing down. Make sure it's seated securely.



Step 3

Turn on the water and let it run for about 30 seconds to prime the new filter. Water discoloration may occur at first use due to activated charcoal.

Maintenance

LOW WATER PRESSURE?

Try these steps:

- Replace the filter a fresh filter can improve water flow.
- Check for blockages make sure nothing is clogging the faucet or filter opening.

CLEANING YOUR BATH TUB FILTER

Wipe it down with a damp sponge.

Avoid using abrasive cleaners, and don't put it in the dishwasher.

BEST PRACTICES FOR USE

Before each use: Run water through the filter for 3 seconds.

If it's been a few days: Run water for 10 seconds before using.

For optimal performance, replace the filter cartridge every 3 months.

NOTE: The Canopy Bathtub Filter is not intended to completely purify or eradicate unsafe water. Ensure that your water system is compliant with local regulations.

Aroma Diffusion

Enjoy aromatherapy in your bathroom with two methods:



In Bath

- Add up to 10 drops of aroma oil to a full bath. For smaller baths, use fewer drops.
- If you experience any irritation, stop using the aroma oil immediately.



Felt Diffuser

- Place 5–10 drops of aroma oil onto the Felt Diffuser.
- Position the diffuser anywhere in your bathroom for a gentle scent.

FAQ

Q: What is in the filter?

A: The Canopy Bathtub Filter employs a multi-layered filtration system to deliver clean, dermatologist-recommended water for your bathtub. Our filter was designed to enhance your skin care routine and promote healthier skin by reducing the amount of chlorine, contaminants and other particulate present in your water.

The Canopy filter is a combination of:

- Granular Activated Carbon
- KDF-55
- Calcium Sulfite

Q: How often should I replace my filter cartridge?

A: For optimal performance, replace the filter cartridge every 3 months. Changes in odor and/or flow of the water being filtered indicate that the filter cartridge should be replaced.

Q: How do I know when the bath water is the right temperature?

- 1. Turn on the water and let it reach your desired temperature.
- 2. The temperature indicator will begin to change color as the water heats up.
- 3. For safety, always use your wrist to check the water temperature before placing your child in the bath.

Q: Why is water coming out of the front of the filter?

A: The Canopy Tub Filter is compatible with a variety of bathtubs and will automatically adjust to your tub's water pressure.

The Built-In Flow Control slows the water just enough to give the filter time to capture the contaminants you don't want soaking into your skin.

If your faucet has especially strong pressure, the Spillway may activate and redirect a trickle of excess water through the front. The Spillway only activates when needed, based on your tub's water pressure. Either way, your filter is working just as it should.
