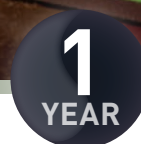

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BORDERED BAR RUNNER

600mm x 190mm

- Produce artwork to the full mat size. Allowing background elements to bleed to the edge of the mat. This is the bleed requirement.
- Fabric area: 576mm x 166mm.
- Safe Print area: 556mm x 146mm. All the important design elements must be inside this area.

LARGE BORDERED BAR RUNNER

894mm x 244mm

- Produce artwork to the full mat size. Allowing background elements to bleed to the edge of the mat. This is the bleed requirement.
- Fabric area: 870mm x 220mm.
- Safe Print area: 850mm x 200mm. All the important design elements must be inside this area.

SMALL BORDERED BAR RUNNER 434mm x 234mm

- Produce artwork to the full mat size. Allowing background elements to bleed to the edge of the mat. This is the bleed requirement.
- Fabric area: 410mm x 210mm.
- Safe Print area: 390mm x 190mm. All the important design elements must be inside this area.

Accepted formats:

- AI (PDF compatible file.)
- PDF (Preserve editing capabilities.)
- EPS
- Packaged INDD with IDML

When supplying:

- File must be the same size requested for print.
- All fonts must be vectored, i.e. "outlined"
- Text must be at least 10pt to be legible on fabric.
- If possible, do not rasterise any artwork.
- Ensure the file only has what needs to be printed. Discard hidden layers.
- Rasterised artwork must be at least 300dpi.

(Considerations can be made for less important elements.)
