The '1170th Worldwide Blood Drive to Give Life through the Love of the Passover' was held in Singapore on 23 April 2023. For 3 years since the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic, the members of the World Mission of God Society Church Singapore Association could not gather at the Bloodbank. With the relaxation of safe management measures, they were once again excited to participate in this annual event physically at the Bloodbank @ HSA. About 178 participants gathered at the Bloodbank on Sunday morning.

An event programme was planned to inspire and

encourage participants to make continuous efforts to take part in future community services.

The event kick-started with an introduction video of the Church God, showcasing humanitarian work being carried out by the Church of God members worldwide. Many participants were impressed by the awards that were presented by the various Governmental organisations to the Church of God.
