They are carbon negative and zero waste at manufacture, making them one of the most sustainable and ethically made bottles on the market! They are completely non toxic, lightweight, durable, easy to use and clean, dishwasher safe and fully recyclable (in the household recycling bin). We are a female founded, family business based in Melbourne. We love to give, and for every bottle sold, we donate 10% to Vision Rescue, helping abandoned women and children living in the slums of Mumbai. We pride ourselves on customer service, so if you're not 100% satisfied with your bottle, please drop us an email and we'll make things right. We have a 12-month warranty for lids and bottles. For any breakages, we provide a new bottle, and we repurpose the damaged parts into new sugarcane products.

CARBON NEGATIVE, ALWAYS POSITIVE

We capture carbon by using the stem of the sugarcane to create the bioplastic resin and utilise the sugarcane waste (begasse) to power the factory. We make sure every part of production is done sustainably and ethically. Our bottles are designed and made in Melbourne, and they are designed to left.

Lightweight, durable, non toxic (BPA, all nasties free), dishwasher safe, fully recyclable in household bins and good looking (the paint won't chip off easily either).

We love to give. For every bottle sold, we give 10% to Vision Rescue, helping abandoned women and children living in the slums of Mumbai. I set out to create the most sustainable bottle possible, and I believe I've done it, and with style.

OUR GOAL

Our goal is to reduce the amount of single use plastic drink bottles. Currently 1 million bottles are purchased globally every minute (gasp!). So we are providing a solution that is kinder to the planet than the average reusable bottle (let's be honest - they use fossil fuels and a lot of energy, and are usually made cheaply in China)

A LIFE CHANGING ENCOUNTER

Over ten years ago, My husband and I travelled and volunteered in India & Nepal for 6 months. What we saw changed us forever. There was one particular slum we visited in Mumbai, where an entire community lived under a bridge next to the biggest rubbish dump in Mumbai. There was plastic waste everywhere and their living conditions were incomprehensible. I knew I needed to do something. We came back to Australia, and as soon as I started Worthy, I knew I would give back to help those exact people (and we have). Our Impact already, through this covid season, has been incredible!
