Paste the wall
The adhesive should be
applied to the surface that
the wallcovering is being
hung onto eg. the wall,
and the paper applied
dry direct from the roll.
Note. The paper can still
be pasted and hung in
the conventional way if
desired.



Spongeable
A finished wallcovering from which dirt and some water-based stains may be cleaned carefully from the front face of the paper with a damp soft cloth or sponge at the time of hanging without causing visible damage, providing it is done whilst the adhesive is still damp. No subsequent washability is claimed or implied.



Half sun Standard lightness. The wallpaper has a minimum rating of 3 when tested in accordance with the EN233 lightfast procedure.



Double cut
The wallpaper is
overlapped and then cut
through both layers. The
excess pieces are then
removed and the paper
smoothed down to create
a perfect butt ioin.



WIDE WIDTH WALLPAPER—INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Over 50" / 130cm wide

Please read these instructions carefully before hanging this wallcovering. It is advisable that a professional decorator is used.

INSPECT EACH ROLL

- Before you begin, ensure the wall covering has been supplied as ordered and has not been damaged in transit. Before cutting and hanging this wallcovering, ensure that all rolls have the same batch reference, and are in good condition. Examination before hanging is the buyer's responsibility. No claim can be accepted for hanging incorrect wallcoverings or after wallcoverings have been cut and hung showing defects which were apparent at the time of hanging. Return any defective roll with its label to the place of purchase.
- Do not assume that the wallcovering will come off the roll the correct way up. Refer to the pattern book, our website or check with the retailer.

PREPARATION

Walls should be clean, dry and even.

 Prepare wall by removing all traces of dirt, old wallpaper, or loose paint.

- Do not hang wallcoverings on any wall with a history of damp.
- Fill any cracks and allow to dry before hanging.
- Absorbent surfaces should be appropriately sized using a diluted wallpaper adhesive. Sealed walls, i.e. painted, should be rubbed with sandpaper to create a 'key'.
- It is important that the walls are of an even and consistent colour. If they are not then consideration should be given to painting them with an appropriate colourwash.
 Alternatively, we recommend that walls be 'lined' horizontally using a good quality lining paper. Allow this to fully dry.

HANGING

- This is a 'paste the wall product'. The decorator should paste the wall and not the back of the wallcovering.
- We recommend the use of a light ready mixed adhesive. Evenly apply the adhesive directly onto the wall using a brush or a short pile emulsion roller.

- our wall coverings have selvedges on both sides. In addition, a 1cm overlap of the design on each side allows for overlap and trimming. The installer should pattern match and double cut on the wall.
- Avoid squeezing paste out of joints.
- Paste must not come in contact with the printed side of the paper covering otherwise staining may occur. In the event that it does, carefully wipe any excess paste from the face of the paper immediately with a clean damp sponge before it dries.
