PREPARATION


BALKENE -HOME-

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Before beginning assembly, be sure to empty contents of carton and make sure all parts are present. If any parts are missing, please contact Customer Service before proceeding.


Place all parts on a soft, level surface for assembly. You will need a **Phillips-head screwdriver** for assembly. Estimated Assembly Time: 1 Hour | DO NOT over-tighten hardware!



Locate the Top Panel ②, Bottom Panel ③, Left and Right Sides ③/①, Drawer Fronts ④, Upper Face Frame ③, Middle Face Frame ③, Base Front/Back Panels ④, and Base Side Panels ④.

Lay indicated parts inside-up (or blank/non-drilled sides facing down). Prepare for assembly by inserting Cam


Bolts ① into flat surfaces and Dowels ② into edges according to the diagram at right.



Align the Cabinet Runners (Left) • with the holes in the interior face of the Left Side •. Fasten using 3 Screws • per runner as shown in the screw placement diagram.

Repeat the above steps to attach the **Cabinet Runners (Right) @** to the **Right Side @**.

Hardware Used: **⑤** Screw (M3.5x12) × 12




Insert Cam Lock Nuts ② into the holes on one side of the Middle Face Frame ③. Rotate each Cam Lock Nut so the arrow (at one point of the Phillips head cross marking) points toward the adjacent hole in the edge of the panel as shown in the diagram above.

NOTE: the Side Panels in the drawing are shown upside-down. Join the Left and Right Sides by installing the Middle Face Frame as shown. Rotate each Cam Lock Nut clockwise until it catches securely on its corresponding Cam Bolt.

Hardware Used: **2** Cam Lock Nut × 2

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Insert Cam Lock Nuts 2 into the holes on the inside of each

Side Panel, rotating the arrows toward the closest panel edge Place the **Top Panel @** upside-down. Align the holes in the

edges of the partially-assembled cabinet box with the Cam Bolts previously installed in the Table Top. Join the Left and Right Sides to the Top Panel by rotating the 4 Cam Lock Nuts until they catch the corresponding Cam Bolts.

Hardware Used: 2 Cam Lock Nut × 4


Install the Upper Face Frame Φ by fitting the previouslyinstalled Dowels in its edge into the holes in the underside of the Table Top as shown. Secure using 2 Screws 3.




3 Screw (M4x40) × 2

Slide the **Back Panel 3** into place along the grooves in the assembled panels.









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Install the **Bottom Panel** by fitting it onto the **Dowels** previously installed in the bottom edges of the **Left** and **Right Sides**. Secure using a **Screw** near each corner as shown.

Hardware Used:

Screw (M4x40) × 4

Assemble the table base by first inserting Cam Lock Nuts 2 into the holes near either end of each Base Side Panel 1. Rotate each Cam Lock Nut so the arrow points toward the short edge of the panel.


Insert the previously-installed **Cam Bolts** near the ends of the **Base Front/Back Panels** into the corresponding holes in the short edges of both **Base Side Panels** to form a rectangular base as shown.

Hardware Used: **2** Cam Lock Nut × 4

Attach the assembled table base to the **Bottom Panel ®** by first inserting **Cam Lock Nuts ®** into the 6 remaining holes on the interior of the table base. Rotate each **Cam Lock Nut** so the arrow points toward the adjoining cam bolt hole in the edge of the table base.

Lower the table base onto the previously-installed Cam Bolts in the Bottom Panel and secure by turning each Cam Lock Nut clockwise until it catches securely on the corresponding Cam Bolt.

Hardware Used: **2** Cam Lock Nut × 6




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
Begin assembling the drawers: Attach **Drawer Side (Left) ©** to **Drawer Back 0** using 2 **Screws 0**, ensuring that the grooved sides are facing in and the groove lines up continuously. Attach the **Drawer Side (Right) ①** in the same manner.

Repeat these steps to begin the second drawer.

Hardware Used: \bullet Screw (M4x30) \times 8




Slide the **Drawer Bottoms** into position in the grooves of the partially-assembled drawers.



Attach the **Drawer Fronts** by first inserting **Cam Lock Nuts** into the holes on the outside of the table base near the open end of the drawer. Rotate each **Cam Lock Nut** so the arrow points toward the adjoining cam bolt hole in the open edge of the drawer.

Insert the previously-installed Cam Bolts in the Drawer Fronts into the holes in the edges of the Drawer Sides and secure by turning each Cam Lock Nut clockwise until it catches securely on the corresponding Cam Bolt.

Hardware Used: **2** Cam Lock Nut × 8




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Install the **Drawer Runners** ②/**Q**: Align each **Drawer Runner** with the wheel toward the back of the drawer and parallel to the **Drawer Side**. Attach each **Runner** using 3 **Screws** ③ positioned as shown in the diagram above the drawer illustration.

Repeat to install **Runners** on the second drawer.

Hardware Used: **G** Screw (M3.5x12) \times 12

Insert the drawers by guiding the wheels at the back of the Drawer Runners OVER the wheels at the front of the Cabinet Runners. You may need to angle the front of the drawer up slightly until the drawer wheels have settled into the track of the Cabinet Runners.
