

GENERAL INFORMATION

This item is made of hollow board and a metal frame. For safe assembly, set up on a dry, soft, secure and clean surface. Do not clean with detergent or chemicals. Do not sit or stand on the unit. Do not place hot items such as coffee cups directly on the surface of this item. Keep away from direct sunlight and water. Do not drag the unit. For indoor use only.



SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING

DO NOT sit or stand or allow children to sit or stand on the assembled product. Make sure connectors are securely in place. Perform periodic checks to make sure the connectors are secure and adjust if needed. Keep unassembled parts and hardware away from children and infants. This package contains small parts and sharp points. Adult assembly required.


CAUTION

PREPARATION

Before beginning assembly, be sure to empty contents of carton and make sure all parts are present. If any parts are missing, please contact Customer Service.

Place all parts on a soft, level surface for assembly. Estimated Assembly Time: 20 Minutes

DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN HARDWARE!

YOU WILL NEED FOR ASSEMBLY (not included): Rubber Mallet* Phillips-head Screwdriver *If none is available, use a hammer, but add padding as necessary to protect parts and surfaces.

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On a soft, nonabrasive surface, place the Left Side ②, Right Side ③, and both Middle/Lower Shelf Faces ① with the inside of each facing up. Insert the threaded ends of a Cam Bolt ① into each of the holes indicated in the diagram (4 per Side and 2 per Shelf Face). Use a Phillips-head screwdriver to tighten each Cam Bolt until its threads are fully inserted.

Peel the paper from each **Foot Pad** and apply the adhesive side firmly to the feet of each **Side**.

Hardware Used:

O Cam Bolt x 12

6 Foot Pad x 4

Place the Middle Shelf ① upside-down on a soft surface. On one of the Middle/Lower Shelf Faces ①, insert a Dowel ③ into the hole midway between the 2 Cam Bolts installed in Step 1. ASSEMBLY NOTE: You may need to tap gently with a rubber mallet to fully seat Dowels.

Join the Shelf Face to the front edge of the Middle Shelf as shown (Shelf Face should form a lip toward the bottom side of the Shelf), by inserting the hardware of the Shelf Face into the holes in the edge of the Shelf. Fasten by inserting a Cam Lock Nut ② (with arrow pointed toward edge) into the hole adjoining each Cam Bolt, then turning the Cam Lock Nuts clockwise until


Attach the **Top Divider** to the **Middle Shelf** by inserting 2 **Dowels** into the bottom edge of the **Divider** then inserting those into the top of the **Shelf** as shown.


To secure, insert 2 **Medium Screws ②** through the indicated holes in the bottom of the **Shelf** and into the **Divider**. Tighten using a Phillips-head screwdriver.

3 Dowel x 2

Medium Screw x 2





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Place the **Bottom Shelf** upside-down on a soft surface. On the remaining Middle/Lower Shelf Face **0**, insert a **Dowel 3** into the hole midway between the 2 Cam Bolts installed in Step 1.

Join the **Shelf Face** to the front edge of the **Lower Shelf** as shown (Shelf Face should form a lip toward the bottom side of the **Shelf**), by inserting the hardware of the Shelf Face into the holes in the edge of the Shelf. Fasten by inserting a Cam Lock Nut 2 (with arrow pointed toward edge) into the hole adjoining each Cam Bolt, then turning the Cam Lock Nuts clockwise until secure

Attach the **Support Leg 0** to the bottom of the **Lower Shelf** by aligning the hole in one end with the hole in the center of the

Shelf, then inserting a **Large Screw** through the top of the Shelf and into the Support Leg. Tighten securely using a Phillipshead screwdriver.

2 Cam Lock Nut × 2 Hardware Used:

② Dowel x 1


4 Medium Screw x 1

Attach the **Bottom Divider ©** to the **Bottom Shelf ©** by inserting 2 **Dowels 3** into the bottom edge of the Divider then inserting those into the top of the Shelf as shown.

To secure, insert 2 Medium Screws 4 through the indicated holes in the bottom of the Shelf and into the Divider. Tighten using a Phillips-head screwdriver.



Attach the Left Side ② to the assembled Shelves: insert Dowels ③ into each of the 3 pairs of holes on the inside front leg of the Left Side. Slide the Dowels and the previously-installed Cam Bolts into the corresponding holes in the left edge of each Middle/Lower Shelf Face ① and into the left edge of the Upper Shelf Face ①.


Secure the **Left Side** to the **Shelves** by inserting a **Cam Lock Nut ②** (with arrow pointed toward edge) into the indicated holes on the underside of the shelves adjoining each **Cam Bolt**, then turning the **Cam Lock Nuts** clockwise until secure.

Hardware Used: **2** Cam Lock Nut × 4

3 Dowel \times 6



Slide the Lower Shelf Backer © into the grooves at the rear of Shelves ①/③. Be sure to slide it all the way into the vertical groove in the inside of the Left Side ⑤.




Attach the **Right Side** to the assembled **Shelves**: insert **Dowels** into each of the 3 pairs of holes on the inside front leg of the **Left Side**. Slide the **Dowels** and the previously-installed **Cam Bolts** into the corresponding holes in the right edge of each **Middle/Lower Shelf Face** and into the right edge of the **Upper Shelf Face**.

Secure the **Right Side** to the **Shelves** by inserting a **Cam Lock Nut ②** (with arrow pointed toward edge) into the indicated holes on the underside of the **Shelves** adjoining each **Cam Bolt**, then turning the **Cam Lock Nuts** clockwise until secure.

Hardware Used: **2** Cam Lock Nut × 4

3 Dowel × 6



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Place the **Top Shelf ©** upside-down on a soft surface. Insert and tighten **Cam Bolts ①** into the 2 indicated holes near the center of the **Shelf**.

Hardware Used: **1** Cam Bolt × 2

Insert a total of 5 **Dowels 3** into the indicated holes in the top edge of the **Left/Right Sides 3**/3 and the middle of the **Upper Shelf Face 3**.

Slide the **Upper Shelf Backer ①** into the grooves at the rear of the **Left/Right Sides**.

Lower the **Top Shelf** onto the partially-assembled unit by inserting the **Cam Bolts** into the **Top Divider** while sliding the **Dowels** into the corresponding holes in the underside of the **Top Shelf**.

Fasten the Cam Bolts by inserting a Cam Lock Nut ② (with arrow pointed toward top edge) into the holes in the side of the Top Divider adjoining each Cam Bolt, then turning the Cam Lock Nuts clockwise until secure.

Insert 6 Large Screws **5** through the Left/Right Sides and Upper Shelf Face upwards into the underside of the Top Shelf. Tighten securely using a Phillips-head Screwdriver.




