



Testing Power

- 1. Plug in the USB power cable to any port. LED strips should illuminate. If not, confirm that the USB port is receiving power (vehicle turned on) or try switching to a different USB port.
- 2. Once illuminated, you can switch through lighting modes using the signal receiver. Located on the signal receiver are two buttons, one labeled "Music", and one labeled "Mode". Press the "Mode" button to toggle through a few default lighting modes.
- 3. Printed on the signal receiver is a QR code, using your device's camera, scan this QR code to download the mobile application. Once downloaded, follow the prompts to connect your kit via bluetooth (ensure kit is on and receiving power). Once connected, test toggling power using the in-app power button, located in the upper right corner:




Lighting Settings Setup

1. Click the settings icon located at top of screen:



2. Under "Effect length", ensure that the points are set to 20, and tap "Close" to confirm the change. This step is optional and the effect length can be changed at any time, however we recommend 20 points for optimal display of the various customizable lighting patterns.



3. To configure color chasing functionality, navigate to the "multi-color" section along the bottom menu, and select the fifth lighting mode (rainbow pattern) labeled "Static".



4. Tap the three dots and select "modify", changing "Static" to "Running Water", as shown. Speed can be left at any value.



5. Once saved, this change should result in a fluid color chasing mode:



Attach LED Strips

- 1. Begin by locating the surfaces where each LED strip will be mounted. (Footwells, rear underseat areas).
- 2. Prepare selected surfaces for mounting by cleaning off any debris, use the included wipes to clean hard plastic/metal surfaces and promote adhesion if needed.
- 3. Peel the mounting tape cover from each LED strip, and apply each strip to its mounting location. If needed, additional mounting aids like zip ties can be used.

Excess Wire Concealment

- Once each LED strip is mounted in place and firmly attached, excess wires can now be concealed. Wires hanging near the footwell of your vehicle can be taped, or zip tied to areas along the top and sides of the footwell. Excess cable slack can also be concealed under floor mats.
- 4. Wires being routed from the front half of the interior to the back can be tucked along the floor in the spaces between the seats to be kept out of sight.
