Submission Deadline: Saturday, May 4, 2024, by 11:59 p.m. EST

Exhibition Dates: June 1 – June 30, 2024

Mediums: painting, drawing, sculpture, mixed media, digital, collage, assemblage, and photography. Accepting both two and three-dimensional pieces.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications are to be submitted via e-mail to dggartinfo@gmail.com on or before the deadline. Up to (two) 2 works, represented as JPEG files may be included for consideration. Label each JPEG file with the artwork title and your first and last name. Please read the full information below prior to applying. We invite you to give your interpretation of the exhibition theme through your work.

Size Restrictions

2D works may be no larger than 48 inches high, 48 inches wide, and 4 inches in depth and not weigh more than 20 pounds (even when framed). All 2D artwork must be suitably framed unless a wrapped canvas is used. Work received without attached hanging hardware will not be included in the show. Works will be on display indoors. Must be original work.

3D works must be free standing, self-supportive or wall mountable, or pedestal ready. Assemblage work does not require a frame. Work may be no longer than 60 inches in its longest dimension and weigh no more than 25 pounds. Pedestal will be provided, if required. Works will be on display indoors. Must be original work.

Shipping & Delivery for Accepted Work

Please do not ship or hand deliver any work until you are notified regarding drop-off and shipping instructions. Applicants are responsible to pay for the delivery and return shipping of their work. Applicants are responsible for any travel expense associated with the shipping and delivery of their artwork. Applicants are also responsible for any travel expense associated with attending the exhibition's opening reception.

Eligibility

All North Carolina residents are eligible.

Applicants may submit two original works.

All works must be the sole work and exclusive property of the submitting artist or photographer. Works must have been created within the last four years.

Sales and Commission

All submitted work must be for sale. Applicants set the sales price. Sales prices are firm. The participant will receive 60% of the sale price and Drinking Gourd Gallery will retain 40%. North Carolina sales tax will be added to the sales price. All sales will be handled by Drinking Gourd Gallery. Work sold during the exhibition will remain on display until the end of the show.

Submission Requirements

Online submissions only. No entry fee. Applicants may submit up to two (2) works, represented as JPEG files, not to exceed 4MB per image.

- 1. Submissions should be sent to dggartinfo@gmail.com and received by the deadline in order to be considered for the upcoming exhibition. Deadline is Saturday, May 4, 2024, by 11:59 p.m. EST.
- 2. In the subject line of your e-mail, please write THE WEIGHT ON MY SHOULDERS with your first and last name.
- 3. For artwork and photography, label each JPEG image file with your first and last name and the artwork title and include the file(s) in your e-mail as attachments.
- 4. In the body of the e-mail list the available work, and include your name, the work title, media, size, and sales price. If you are submitting mixed-media work, you must include the names of all media used in the creation of the artwork. Please also include a short bio and a telephone number where you can be reached.

Receipt of your submission will be confirmed by e-mail.
