

This system has the tools you need to effectively clear rats & mice from your property and protect against any newcomers. An easy, toxin free system that enables you to contribute and support conservation efforts in New Zealand.



Positioning your traps for maximum effect:

Roofspace

Rat Hatch: Multi-rodent trap

- **Your ceiling access hatch** – This makes for an easy install, simply remove the hatch, and install using the tools and fasteners supplied.
- **Outside in the soffit** – This can be accessed/managed by others if you are away.
- **Garage/outbuildings** – Anywhere that connects to your roof spaces.

Note: Roof spaces are the no.1 breeding location for rodents, the most important area to control.



Horizontal or Vertical

D-Rat: Multi-rodent trap

- **Trees** – Small with branches and some nearby cover catch best, especially ones that might give rodents access to your roof.
- **Inside the house** – Warm dry spots away from kids and pets, like a hot water cupboard.
- **Shed/Garage** – Place trap elevated on a stud or using the supplied cable tie fix to a rafter or on to a length of timber and lean up against the wall.



Ground based

Supervisor Max: Multi-rodent trap

- **Inside** – Warm dry spots, along walls, behind furniture.
- **Near your compost** – Ideally place as near to the entry point or where you can see some activity.
- **Shed/Garage** – place on the ground alongside walls or objects that offer them an escape if startled.

Note: Rodents are wary, do not place trap in a corner or highly exposed areas.



Bait Sample

Store in a cool dry place, mix occasionally to stop oils from splitting and add a small drop of vanilla flavoured essence.

Note: We recommend you refresh the bait in your traps every 1 to 2 weeks.
