

Release Instructions



Phytoseiulus persimilis Two-Spotted Spider Mite Predator

- Predators are highly perishable!
- Release them the same day as received. Early morning, late afternoon, or when temperatures are not extremely hot. Cloudy days are perfect all day.
- Allow predators to warm up to room temperature and release immediately.
- To release from bottles, mix predators into medium by slowly and gently rotating bottles every few minutes.
- Mites are fragile – do not shake. Apply by sprinkling onto dry foliage.
- Begin releases at first sign of spider mites. Intensive monitoring should detect only occasional colonies.
- Do not release immediately before or after pesticide applications.

Storage: Keep the package or vial in a cool location until you can release the predators. Ideal storage temperature is 50°F. (10°C).
