Tools needed:

4mm Allen key, Phillips screwdriver

Includes Hardware.

Step 1

Remove 3rd row upper handles.

Pop off bolt covers to expose both phillip screws and unbolt.

(SAVE FACTORY BOLTS SINCE THE WILL BE RE USED)



Step 2

Build you Cubby.

Lay your 36" x20" panel down and place the 1" rails across the longer side and place and stand the 2" rails across the shorter end.

ADD ALL T NUTS THROUGH THE EXTRUSION RAIL NEEDED TO MOUNT ALONG THOSE SECTIONS.



ADD THE 4 CORNERS to combine the rails together.


"make sure you square out all ends, leave a bit loose"







Step 3
Once you have the corners added, T nuts placed, Start adding the allen through bolts and washers.









Step 4 ADD THE BACK PLATE AND FRONT FACE CORNERS



Once you have your cubby built, mount up the side hangers that will be bolting up to where your factory handles sit.





ONCE YOU HAVE YOUR CUBBY PUT TOGETHER

TIGHTEN ALLTHE BOLTS AND INSTALL.
