

When your plant arrives

Remove the plant from the box, water if the compost feels dry and place where it is to grow.

How to care for Oracaera

Keep compost moist but don't allow
Dracaena to sit in water. Reduce watering
in winter. Mist regularly. Cut off
any leaves that go brown. Repot
Dracaena if it gets too big.

Where to place Dracaera

Place in a room with light shade, such as a living room or hallway. Keep out of draughts and away from radiators. Make sure the temperature does not fall below 13°C. Dracaena leaves are toxic to pets.

Possible problems and how to solve them

Brown tips on leaves are usually caused by dry air – use a mister to increase humidity. Bleached patches on leaves can be caused by too much sun.

General care advice

Wipe leaves to remove dust and mist regularly throughout the year.
