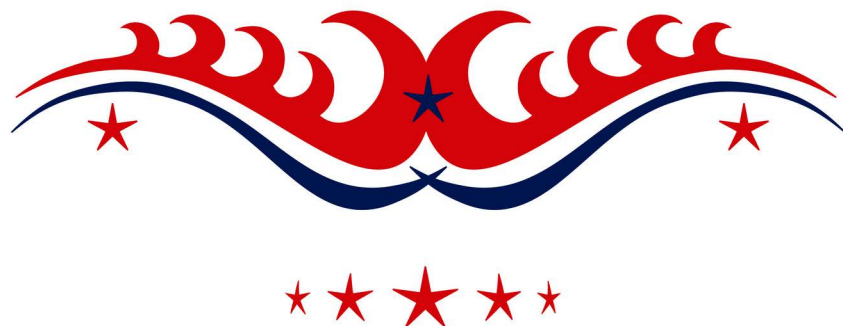


Introduction to Notebooking Pages

You will notice that some of the pages are lined and others are unlined. This has been done to provide you and your student with some flexibility in their notebooking work with American Government. Please note that some of the lined pages are done in early elementary style with a dashed line between two solid lines, while other pages are single spaced for older students.
